DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set cement retainer at 3253', squeezed perforation from 3310' to 3330' with 75 sacks cement. Top of cement at 3246'. Perforated 7" casing from 3110' to 3230' with 120 shots. Well tested 50 MCF gas/day. Treated through perforation with 500 gallons acid. Tested dry. Treated with 2000 gallons acid. Well showed slight amount of gas. Perforated 7" casing from 2985' to 3110'. Unloaded hole with outside gas. Flowed water at rate of 45 bbls per hr. with 4000 cu. ft. gas/day.
