DETAILS OF WORK

The following procedure was followed in abandoning the Leonard Oil Company No. 2: Total Depth 11,235'.

1. 5-1/2" casing was shot off at 7650' and pulled. A 25-sacks cement plug was placed in the 5-1/2" stub.
2. Hole loaded with heavy mud from 7625' to surface.
3. Recovered 7650' of 5-1/2" casing.
4. Spotted 15-sacks plug at 1150' in 9-5/8" casing.
5. Shot 9-5/8" casing off at 1138' and recovered 1138' of 9-5/8" casing.
6. Spotted 20-sacks plug in 9-5/8" stub (top at 1125').
7. A 20-sacks cement cap was placed at the surface in the 13-3/8" casing.
