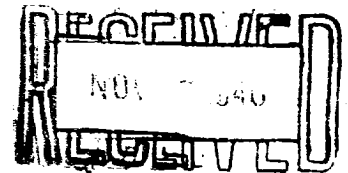

RE-COMPLETION DATA, FEDERAL ELMICOT # 1

Zone 6385' - 6995' flowing approximately 10 barrels per day. Plug back to 6640'. Test 5500'-6620'- Water. Test 6580'-6590'- Water, Test 6530'-6570'- Water, Test 6420'-6455'- Water, Test 6390'-6410'- Water, Test 6330'-6380'- Very slight gas with show of oil and water.

Plug back to 5725'. Perforated zone 5575'-5720' with 420 holes. Leave 5625'-5660' blank. Acidize 5660'-5725' with 2,000 and 6,000 gallon acid. Result 2 barrels per hour. Acidize 5575' -5625' with 1,000 and 5,000 gallon acid. Result total zone swabbing 70 barrels per 24 hours.

Rig pumping unit. Initial production 70 barrels per 24 hours.
