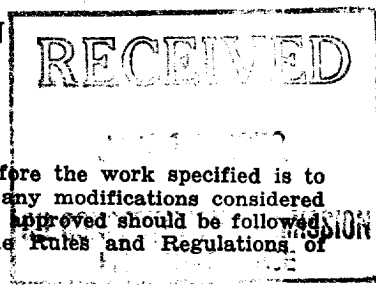

Drilled to total depth of 260'. Ran 13" OD casing to 260' and cemented with 260 sacks. The Halliburton process was used and the cement circulated to surface. On January 11, 1952, at approximately 7:00 a.m. will drill cement plug and test casing shut-off.
