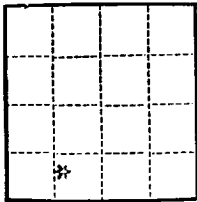

DETAILS OF WORK

Cactus Drilling Co. spudded 11" hole on 8-9-63. On 8-9-63, 8-5/8" OD 24# J-55 casing was set at 318' with 125 sx. cement circulated. After 1800 hours, tested casing with 600 PSI for 30 minutes. Test OK. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 318' and resumed drilling operations.
