It is proposed to set retrievable BP at 5540'. Perforate 5403-45', 5437-39' and 5509-11' in 500 gallons of 15% NEA with 4 - 0.45" JHPS. Acidize down tubing w/3,000 gallons of 7-1/2% NEA. Pull tubing. Frac down 5-1/2" OD casing with 21,000 gallons gelled brine, 27,000 pounds 20/40 mesh sand in 3 stages of 1,000 gallons pad, 6,000 gallons with 1-1/2 pounds sand per gallon with 500 gallons of 15% NEA and 8 RCTN ball sealers between stages. Recover BP. Run tubing. Place well on production and test. Work to start on approval.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
