The subject well is inactive pending change in economic conditions which will permit us to re-work the well or to plug and abandon. In the meantime, the tank battery for this well has approximately 175 barrels of oil in storage which can be moved. We request permission to commingle this oil with that of our Hill "A"#2 well (Teague Blinebry Field) so that the oil may be sold.

We shall make full accounting of disposition of the oil from the Imperial Tubb Drinkard Field on our next C-115. If this disposition requires a new allowable, we would appreciate having the allowable assigned.
