Ran 3249' (78Jts) 7" casing at 3260'. Cemented with 425 sacks. Completed 7:15 AM, 7-28-49. Ran temperature survey. Top cement 1830'. Moved off rotary and moved in cable tools, 8-7-49. Before drilling plug bailed hole dry, on 4 hour test remained dry. Drilled cement plug 8-9-49. Drilled cement and 6" formation. Tested by bailing method 4 hours. Remained dry. Drilling proceeded.
