A study of the producing interval for your Olsen Phillips Well No. 3 in Unit N of Section 6, T-25-S, R-37-E indicates that the well is producing from the Seven Rivers formation rather than the Queen as shown on Form C-104. Since the top of the Queen is at 3467 feet and the perforations are from 3310-3354 feet, the interval is above the lower 100 feet of the Seven Rivers formation and the well should correctly be classified as an oil well in the Jalmat Pool rather than the Langlie Mattix Pool.

Please file Form C-110 showing this change in pool designation and requesting permission to commingle the production from this well with other wells on the same lease presently prorated in the Langlie Mattix Pool.
