## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 3345' - Hole bridged back to 3326' and shot with 140 quarts of Glycerine from 3253-3326' on March 28, 1947. Shot bridged - went in with tools, broke through bridge and well started flowing to pit on March 30, 1947, continued to clean out to April 7, 1947. Tubing run to 3258' and well produced at rate of 5 barrels of fluid per hour, 30% water.
