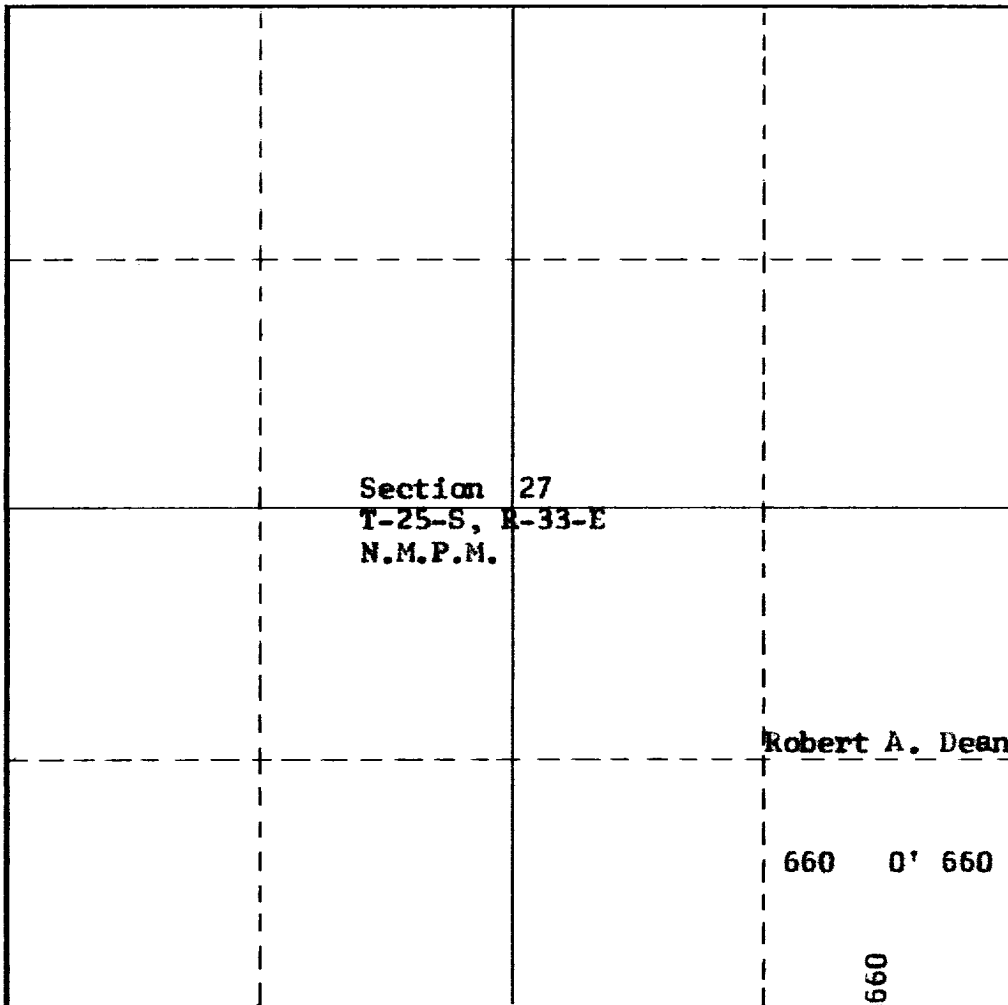

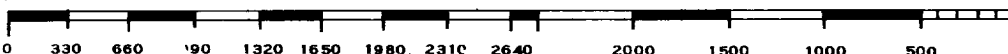

DESIGNATION OF AGENT

COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC LANDS:

The undersigned is, on the records of the State Land Office as Unit Operator under the Red Hills Unit Agreement, Lea County, New Mexico, approved January 22, 1963, and hereby designates:

as its agent, with full authority to act in its behalf in complying with the terms of the Unit Agreement and regulations applicable thereto and on whom the supervisor or his representative may serve written or oral instructions in securing compliance with the terms of the unit agreement with respect to drilling, testing and completing unit well No. 6 in the SE/4 SE/4 Section 27, T25S, R33E, W.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

It is understood that this designation of agent does not relieve the Unit Operator of responsibility for compliance with the terms of the unit agreement. It is also understood that this designation of agent does not constitute an assignment of any interest under the unit agreement or any lease committed thereto.

In case of default on the part of the designated agent, the Unit Operator will make full and prompt compliance with all regulations, lease terms, or orders of the Commissioner of Public Lands or the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

The Unit Operator agrees promptly to notify the Commissioner of any change in the designated agent.

This designation of agent is deemed to be temporary and in no manner a permanent agreement.

This designation is given only to enable the agent herein designated to drill the above-specified unit well. Unless sooner terminated, this designation shall terminate when there

is filed a complete file of all required reports pertaining to subject well. It is also understood that this designation of agent is limited to field operations and does not cover administrative action requiring specific authorization of the Unit Operator.
