Total Depth - 3605' Lime; 7" casing at 3349'.

This well was completed on October 18, 1938, with an initial production of 46 bbls. oil in 24 hrs., after shooting with 280 quarts of nitro-glycerine from 3510' to 3598'.

The production has declined to approximately 2 bbls. per day, and we desire permission to deepen this well in the same pay section from 3605' to approximately 3640' and shoot with nitre-glycerine from approximately 3580' to 3640' in an effort to make a commercial producer out of this small well.
