Dear Bob,

Per your request I visited the above site and have the following recommendations for you.

Texas New-Mexico Pipeline Co. should submit a NMOCD C-103 form with their remediation work plan attached for approval. We recommend the plan contain the following:

1. The clean-up should be per NMOCD guidelines for leaks and spills.
2. Since this is a crude oil pipeline spill Tex-New Mex should make a waste determination to determine if the contaminated soil is RCRA hazardous waste.
3. The C-103 or work plan should describe how the waste was generated and give the detail legal location, map, etc.
4. The land owner should be notified and concur with the submitted plan.

Please submit the above documentation to our office for approval.
