Regarding official responsibility for environmental concerns on the three properties/remediation permits listed below:

1RP-2079, 1RP-419 and 3RP-286.

All three of these permit numbers had been inappropriately designated to ConocoPhillips in the eDOC Imaging File, which is available for public viewing on the Oil Conservation Division (OCD) on line website.

Although it cannot be known exactly how/why they were so listed, it was perhaps inadvertently done in previously used data base structure for OCD files. This information was carried over into new/current data base structure. Under current construct, ConocoPhillips may continue to be shown as responsible party in the imaged file header, however, in the official Administrative Order Section of OCD data base the correct (not ConocoPhillips) responsible party is now listed for the RP identification. At the current time, OCD IT group informs me they cannot alter this circumstance. Perhaps in future, but not in the immediate time frame.

This communication can be used in lieu of a more traditional Closure Document for purposes of tracking site activity on ACO aspects/requirements for these three RP's.

ConocoPhillips is not the responsible party for the three listed RPs' indicated above..

OCD would like to thank you for your efforts on this matter and in particular, for collating documentation for OCD decision process.
