Dear Director Fuge,

EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its Driver 14 Fed Com 210H well (API No. 30-025-50669; sundry approval pending). The spacing unit dedicated to the well is comprised of the E2W2 & W2E2 of Sections 11 and 14, Township 23 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico and is within the Bell Lake; Bone Spring, North (5150). The horizontal spacing unit for the well is approximately 640 acres and includes proximity tracts with the defining well being the Driver 14 Fed Com 504H.

This well has not yet been drilled. It is proposed to be drilled as follows:

- The surface location is located 931 feet from the South line, 1116 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 14,
- The bottom hole location is located 100 feet from the North line, 1330 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 11,
- The first take point is located 100 feet from the South line, 1330 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 14,
- The last take point is located 100 feet from the North line, 1330 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 11.

The acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules. The proposed completed interval is unorthodox because it will be closer than 330 feet to the eastern boundary. It encroaches on the spacing units in the E2E2 of Sections 11 and 14. Approval of the unorthodox location will allow EOG to use its preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells, which will prevent waste.

**Exhibit A** is the draft C-102 sundry. This plat shows the location of the proposed well, including the proposed unorthodox, completed interval. The proposed completed interval encroaches on the spacing unit/tracts to the east. The second page of Exhibit A is the approved APD showing the designated pool and API number.

**Exhibit B** is a plat that shows the Driver 14 Fed Com 210H well in relation to the adjoining spacing units/tracts to the east.

**Exhibit C** is a certification from the landman indicating that he has reviewed the tracts affected by this request. Exhibit C includes a list of the affected parties and **Exhibit D** provides proof that a copy of this application, including exhibits, was mailed to each affected party. This notice advises affected parties that any objection must be filed in writing with the Division within 20 days from the date the Division receives the application.

**Exhibit E** is a statement from a petroleum engineer providing justification for the requested non-standard location.

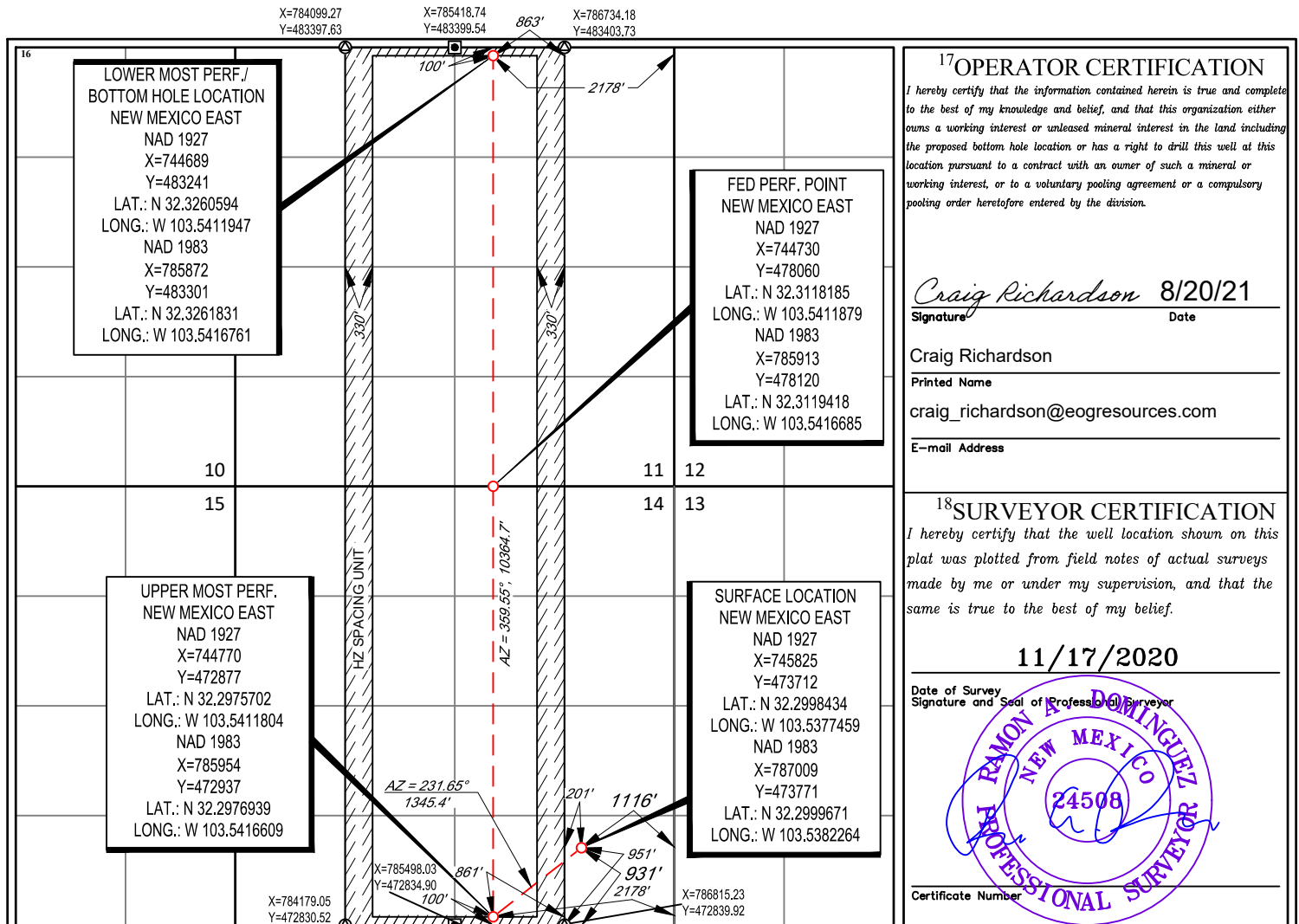

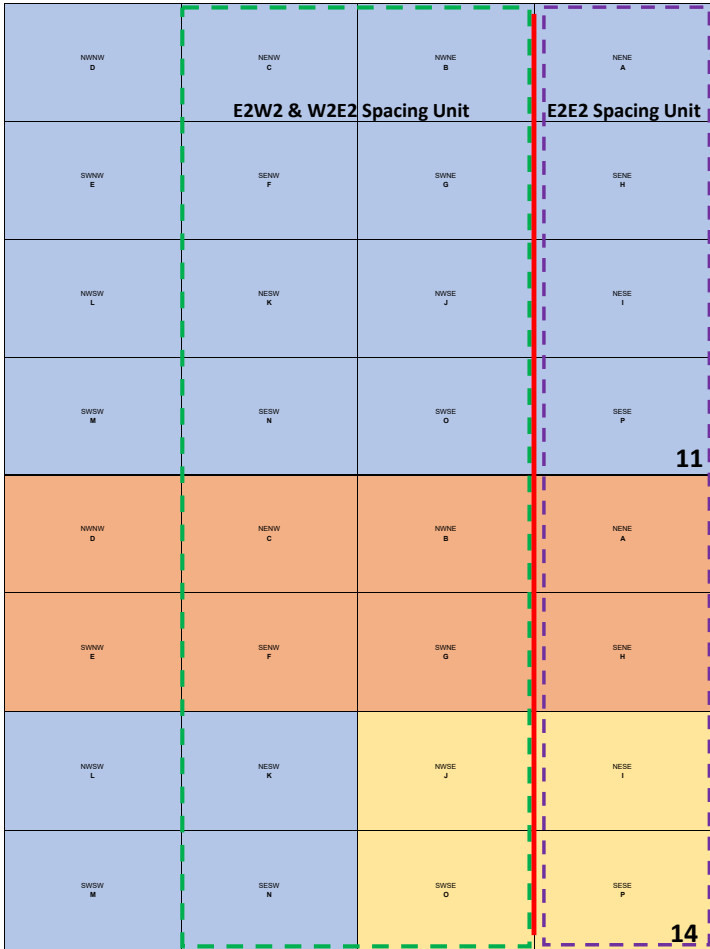
