Devon Energy Production Company, L.P., ("Devon"), OGRID No. 6137, is seeking administrative approval of a nonstandard spacing and proration unit ("NSP") for the Prairie Fire 27-25 Fed Com 722H Well (the "722H Well") (API 30-015-Pending). This Well was originally pooled in Case 23550, Pooling Order No. R-22764, in which the OCD assigned the WC 20S29E23:WOLFCAMP (Oil) Pool (Pool Code 98357) to the unit underlying the S/2 NE/4 of Section 27, and the S/2 N/2 of Sections 26 and 25, in Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico ("Spacing Unit"). The OCD later found that this Wolfcamp oil pool overlaps in the S/2 NE/4 of Section 27 with an existing pool, the Burton Flat; Wolfcamp, East (Gas) (Pool Code 73480), which is a gas pool. Pursuant to the guidance of the Division, Devon seeks to reconcile the gas pool requirements through approval of the Spacing Unit as a non-standard spacing unit.

Prairie Fire 27-25 Fed Com 722H Well:

- Surface Location (SL): 208' from the North line and 710' from the West line of Section 27, Township 20 South, Range 29 East;
- Bottom Hole Location (BHL): 1980' from the North line and 20' from the East line of Section 25, Township 20 South, Range 29 East;
- First Take Point (FTP): 1980' from the North line and 2540' from the East line of Section 27, Township 20 South, Range 29 East;
- Last Take Point (LTP): 1980' from the North line and 100' from the East line of Section 25, Township 20 South, Range 29 East.

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Devon has included as Exhibit B, a letter explaining why this application is needed. Devon pooled the above referenced Unit in Case No. 23550 and received Pooling Order No. R-22764. Although the gas pool only overlaps the N/2 NE/4 of Section 27, as a precaution, Devon has provided notice to all parties in tracts or units adjoining the Spacing Unit around the entire perimeter of the Spacing Unit pursuant to 19.15.16.15B(5)(b)(ii).

Devon attests that, on or before submission of this application, it provided notice to the affected persons as described herein; said notice described satisfies all provisions of NMAC 19.15.16.15B(5)(b)(ii) and NMAC 19.15.15.11B(4). Copies of the application and required plat maps are furnished. Devon provides herein a sectional map of this area, attached as Exhibit C. Proof of mailing, along with a copy of the notice letter sent to listed affected persons and parties, is attached hereto as Exhibit D. These wells do not have a compulsory pooling case associated with them.

Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. ("Devon") respectfully requests administrative approval of a non-standard spacing unit for the Prairie Fire Well referenced above. Devon pooled the above referenced Unit in Case No. 23550 and received Pooling Order No. R-22764. The pool assigned to the Unit was the WC 20S29E23; Wolfcamp (Pool Code 98357), designated as an oil pool. During the permitting process, it was discovered that this Wolfcamp pool overlaps in the S/2 NE/4 of Section 27 with an existing pool, the Burton Flat; Wolfcamp, East (Gas) (Pool Code 73480), which is a gas pool. Devon wishes to address this inadvertent overlap and discrepancy between the gas and oil pools in a manner that the Division deems necessary and account for notice to offset operators in order to protect correlative rights. The Division has informed us that applying for approval of the Unit as a non-standard unit to account for the gas pool is the best way to proceed. By addressing this matter in a timely manner, Devon will be able to meet its drilling obligations and maximize production from the Unit.


