Re: Application of EOG Resources, Inc. for administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its Red Hills North Unit 581H well, dedicated to the NENW (Lot 3), SENW, E2 of SW4 of Section 1, E2W2 of Section 12, and E2 of NW4 of Section 13, Township 25 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Dear Director Fuge,

EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its Red Hills North Unit 581H well (API No. not yet assigned). The spacing unit dedicated to the well is comprised of the NENW (Lot 3), SENW, the E2 of the SW4 of Section 1, the E2W2 of Section 12, and the E2 of the NW4 of Section 13, Township 25 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico and is within the Red Hills; Lower Bone Spring (51020). The horizontal spacing unit for the well is approximately 399.89 acres and does not include proximity tracts.

This well has not yet been drilled nor approved. It is proposed to be drilled as follows:

- The <u>surface location</u> is located 968 feet from the North line, 271 feet from the East line (Lot 1) of Section 2,
- The <u>bottom hole location</u> is located 100 feet from the South line, 1370 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 13,
- The <u>first take point</u> is located 100 feet from the North line, 1370 feet from the West line (Lot 3) of Section 1,
- The <u>last take point</u> is located 100 feet from the South line, 1370 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 13.

The acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules. The proposed completed interval is unorthodox because it will be closer than 330 feet to the western boundary. It encroaches on the Red Hills North Unit Boundary in the W2 of the NW4 in Section 1. Approval of the unorthodox

location will allow EOG to use its preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells, which will prevent waste.

Exhibit A is the pending C-102 in the APD showing the designated pool and horizontal lateral. This plat also shows the location of the proposed well, including the proposed unorthodox, completed interval. The proposed completed interval encroaches on the Red Hills North Unit Boundary in the W2 of the NW4 in Section 1.

Exhibit B is a plat that shows the Red Hills North Unit 581H well in relation to the adjoining Red Hills North Unit Boundary to the west.

Exhibit C is a certification from the landman indicating that he has reviewed the tracts affected by this request. Exhibit C includes a list of the affected parties and **Exhibit D** provides proof that a copy of this application, including exhibits, was mailed to each affected party. This notice advises affected parties that any objection must be filed in writing with the Division within 20 days from the date the Division receives the application.

Exhibit E is a statement from a petroleum engineer providing justification for the requested non-standard location.




