

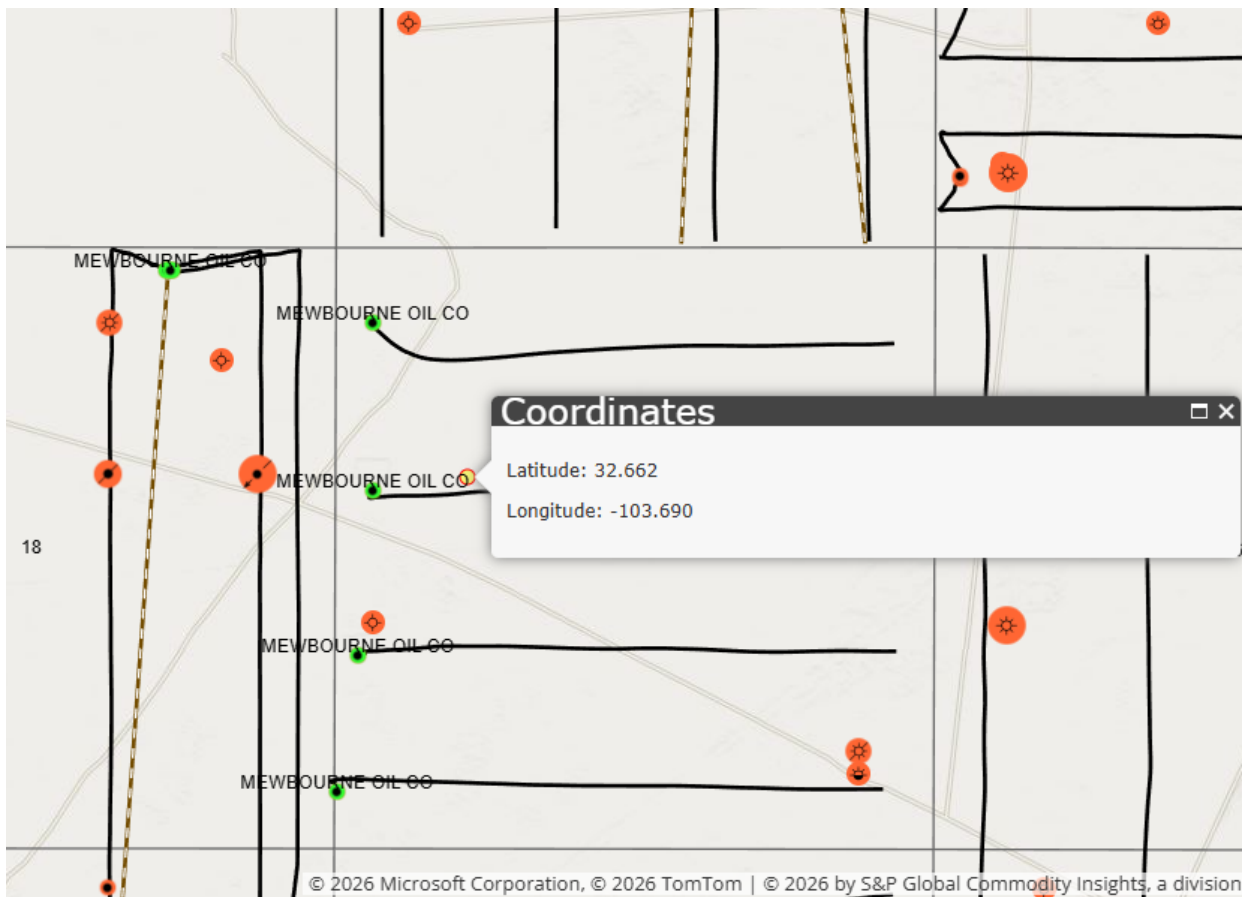

Greetings Mr. Levasseur,

On February 16, 2026, Mewbourne Oil Company notified the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (“OCD”) that it is protesting the following SWD permit request application of Coterra Energy Operating Co. for disposal:

- Spyglass 17 SWD No. 1, Unit E, Section 17, Township 19 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico

Mewbourne Oil Company is identified as an affected person for the referenced application. For the application to proceed, Coterra Energy Operating Co. has two options: either resolve the matter with the protesting party or go to hearing before the Division. If the protest is withdrawn, then the application could be processed administratively. Meanwhile, OCD will retain your application until a resolution is reached on the status of the submittals.
