Please see the attached letter and proposed workover plan requesting a good-cause administrative extension of injection authority for the Mobley SWD #1, API No. 30-015-45072, pursuant to 19.15.26.12(C)(2) NMAC.

Mobley SWD #1 is currently in TA status and has been shut in since June 26, 2025, due to a leaking packer. Because the well has now been shut in for approximately 11 months, we are approaching the deadline to resume injection before the injection authority is at risk of termination. I am sending this email as a formal request for OCD's administrative extension of the injection authority to allow Western Midstream sufficient time to complete the proposed corrective work and required testing before returning the well to service.

Western Midstream intends to perform a remedial workover to restore the well-to-injection service. We plan to file a C-103G NOI Workover with the current and proposed wellbore schematics and complete the required MIT and bradenhead testing prior to resuming injection. The proposed workover scope includes pulling the RBP currently set at approximately 15,080 feet, setting a new packer at approximately 15,085 feet, landing a new 5-inch by 4-inch tubing string, and performing successful MIT and BHT tests prior to resuming injection operations.

Please advise if OCD requires any additional conditions, witnessing, filings, or information before we proceed.

Dear Injection Permitting Team,

Solaris Water Midstream, LLC requests a six month good-cause administrative extension of injection authority for Mobley SWD #1, API No. 30-015-45072, pursuant to 19.15.26.12(C)(2) NMAC.

The well has been shut in since June 26, 2025, due to a leaking packer. Solaris previously did not intend to repair the well through a workover. However, after the acquisition of Solaris by Western Midstream and the Western Midstream's review of the well history and current condition, Western Midstream believes the well can be returned to service with the appropriate corrective work. Specifically, by replacing the packer and installing a new tubing string will allow the well to reestablish mechanical integrity and resume injection in compliance with OCD requirements.

The well also has recent mechanical integrity history supporting this request. Following a tubing replacement workover in June 2025, the well passed a state-witnessed MIT on June 23, 2025. Based on this history, we believe the well remains a viable SWD candidate, provided the proposed workover is completed and the well successfully passes the required testing prior to returning to injection.

The proposed workover scope includes pulling the RBP currently set at approximately 15,080 feet, setting a new packer at approximately 15,085 feet, landing a new 5-inch by 4-inch tubing string, and performing successful MIT and BHT tests prior to resuming injection operations. The proposed workover plan is provided.

Since the well has not yet reached one continuous year of non-injection, we are submitting this request in advance of the one-year deadline under 19.15.26.12(C) NMAC. We are requesting this extension so that Western Midstream has sufficient time to complete the proposed workover, demonstrate mechanical integrity, and return the well to active injection service without automatic termination of injection authority under 19.15.26.12(C)(1) NMAC.
