You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. 19.15.16.15(B)(3)(a) NMAC governs this proposed well and provides that the operator shall dedicate to each horizontal well a standard horizontal spacing unit that comprises of one or more contiguous tracts that the horizontal well's completed interval penetrates, each of which consists of a governmental quarter section or equivalent. 19.15.16.15(C)(1)(a) NMAC governs the distance in the horizontal plane from any point in the

completed interval to any outer boundary of the horizontal spacing unit, measured along a line perpendicular to the completed interval or to the tangent thereof, shall be a minimum of 660 feet for a well. 19.15.16.15(C)(1)(b) NMAC governs the first and last take point of a horizontal well shall be no closer than 330 feet within the horizontal plane, to any outer boundary of the horizontal spacing unit.

The request to deviate from an orthodox location has met all requirements of 19.15.16.15 (C)(5)(a) NMAC. It is understood that you are seeking this exception in order to create a non-standard location, comprised of Take Points referenced above, within the described Horizontal Spacing Unit. *The entire horizontal spacing unit is comprised of two pools: (1) Wilson; Bone Spring [64560] and (2) Wilson; Bone Spring, South [96880]. This NSL pertains to the former portion of the producing spacing unit, Pool Code No. 64560.*

This well's completed interval is as close as 100 feet to the northern and 110 feet to the southern edge of the horizontal spacing unit. Encroachment will impact the following tracts.

Section 18, encroachment to the SW/4
Section 31, encroachment to the NW/4

The Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in 19.15.2.7(A)(8) NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches.

Division understands you are seeking this unorthodox location due to the spacing unit transversing two pools with dissimilar setback requirements. The complete spacing unit will adhere to gas setbacks creating an unorthodox location within the Wilson; Bone Spring [64560] pool/formation underlying the E/2 W/2 Section 19 and the E/2 NW/4 Section 30. Thus, preventing waste and protecting correlative rights of affected parties.

Your application has been filed under 19.15.16.15(C)(6) NMAC, 19.15.15.13 NMAC and 19.15.4.12 (A)(2) NMAC.

Per 19.15.15.13 (B) NMAC, **Division approves this unorthodox location.**

Reference this NSL order number on the As Drilled C-102 submitted with the Authorization to Transport, to place this well into production.

The above approvals are subject to your following all other applicable Division rules.

Matador Production Company (OGRID No. 228937), pursuant to Division Rules 19.15.16.15(C)(6) and 19.15.15.13 NMAC and applicable rules governing acreage and well location requirements for the Wilson; Bone Spring [64560], seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Dee Osborne 1930 State Com 132H** well (API No. 30-025-PENDING), in a 320-acre, more or less, spacing unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of irregular Sections 19 and 30, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The Dee Osborne 1930 State Com 132H traverses two pools. This application is specific to the Wilson; Bone Spring [64560] portion of the spacing unit, which is comprised of 240-acres, being the E/2 W/2 of irregular Section 19 and E/2 NW/4 of irregular Section 30, T21S-R30E.

The location of the **Dee Osborne 1930 State Com 132H** well is as follows:

- Surface location: 179' FNL and 1,060' FWL (Lot 1) of irregular Section 19
- First take point: 100' FNL and 1,980' FWL (Unit C) of irregular Section 19
- Last take point: 110' FSL and 1,980' FWL (Unit N) of irregular Section 30
- Bottom hole location: 110' FSL and 1,980' FWL (Unit N) of irregular Section 30

The Division has informed Matador that the E/2 SW/4 of irregular Section 30 is in a Bone Spring gas pool, while the remainder of the spacing unit (E/2 W/2 of irregular Section 19 and E/2 NW/4

of irregular Section 30) is in a Bone Spring oil pool. Since the well traverses both an oil and gas pool, Matador understands that the gas setbacks apply to the entirety of the spacing unit; thus, both the first and last take points are at a non-standard well location, encroaching on Earthstone Operating LLC's ("Earthstone") Dovetail spacing unit to the north and Permian Resources Operating, LLC's ("Permian") Cartman spacing unit to the south. Accordingly, Matador files this application for approval of non-standard locations for the first and last take points of the well to allow for the 100 foot setbacks for oil wells, given that the majority of the well is in an oil pool and Matador's technical team believes the gas-oil-ratio of the well will be consistent with that of Bone Spring wells typically placed in oil pools.

Exhibit A is a Form C-102, specific for the Wilson; Bone Spring [64560], showing that the proposed first and last take points for the **Dee Osborne 1930 State Com 132H** well encroaches on the spacing units to the north and south.

Exhibit B is a plat for the subject area that shows the proposed **Dee Osborne 1930 State Com 132H** well in relation to Earthstone's Dovetail spacing unit to the north and Permian's Cartman spacing unit to the south. The exhibit also includes a statement from the landman that identifies the offsetting affected New Mexico State Land Office ("SLO") leases. Accordingly, the "affected persons" are Earthstone, Permian and the SLO.

Exhibit C is a spreadsheet listing all affected persons and includes tracking information demonstrating that each of the affected persons was sent a copy of this application with all attachments by certified mail advising that any objections must be filed in writing with the Division within 20 days from the date the Division receives the application. 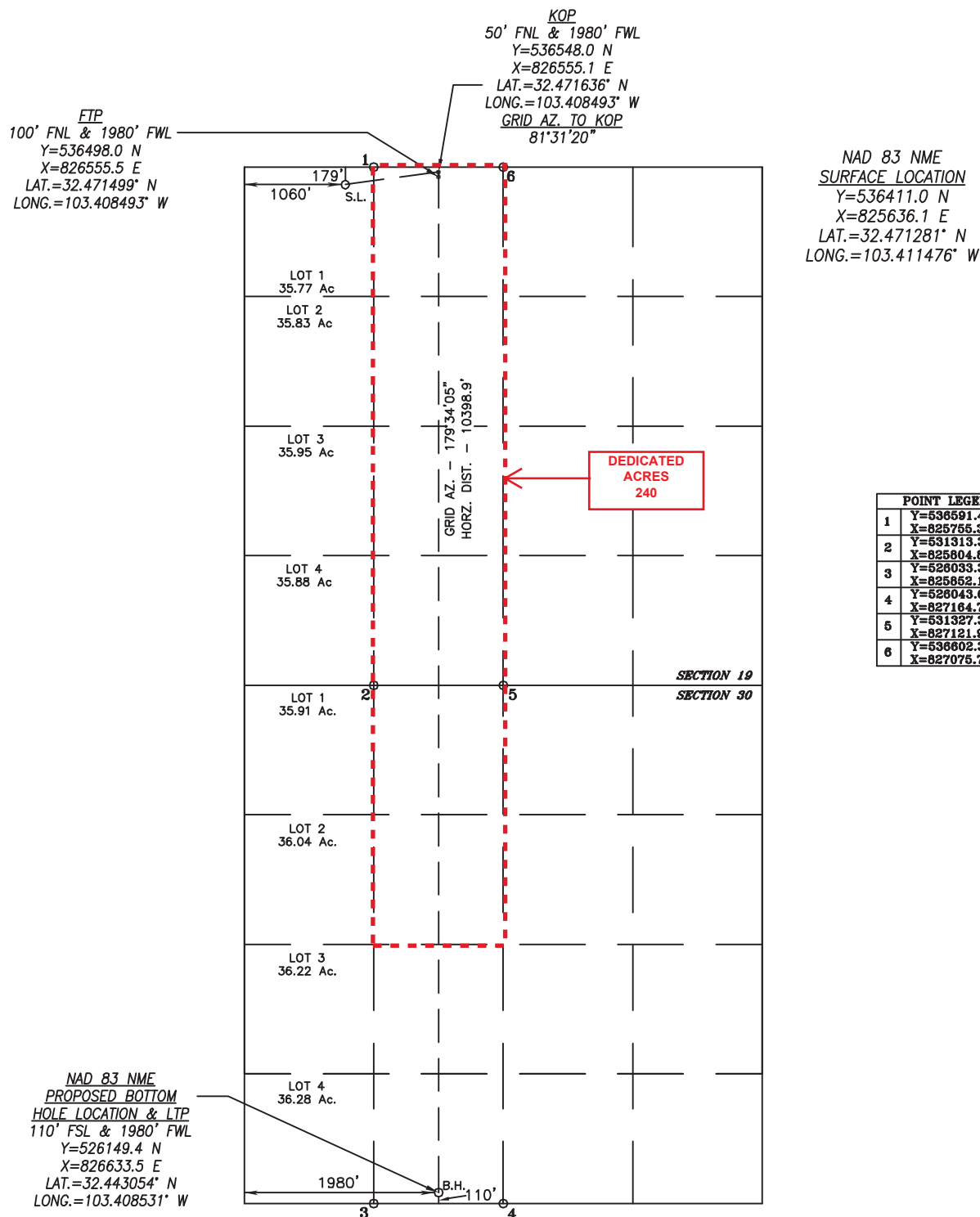

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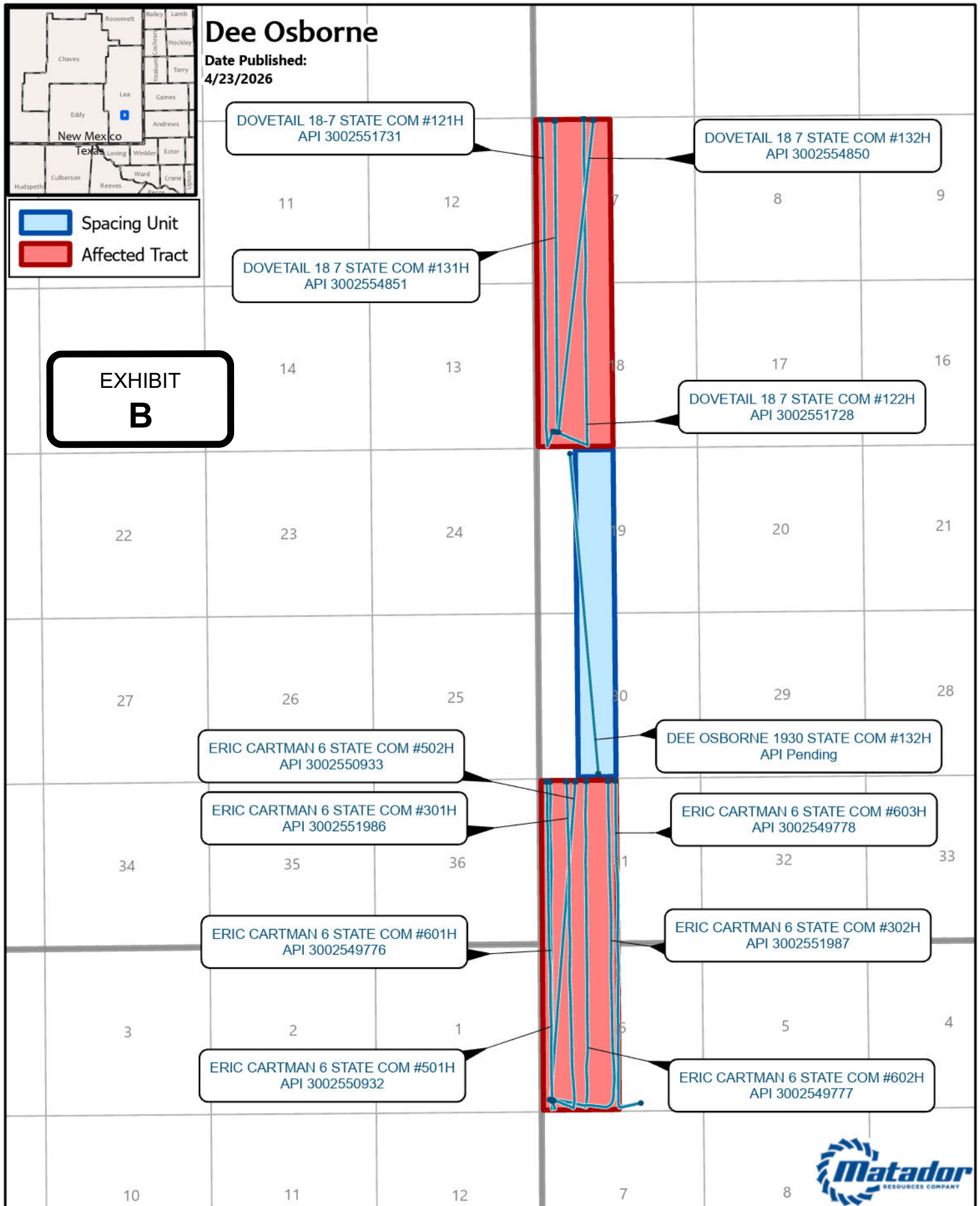
