You have requested to drill this horizontal well at an unorthodox well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. 19.15.16.15(B)(1)(a) NMAC governs this proposed well and provides that the operator dedicate a horizontal well at a standard horizontal spacing unit that comprises of one or more contiguous tracts that the horizontal well's completed interval penetrates, each of which consists of a governmental quarter - quarter section or equivalent. 19.15.16.15(C)(1)(a) NMAC governs the distance in the horizontal plane from any point in the completed interval to any outer boundary of the horizontal spacing unit, measured along a line

perpendicular to the completed interval or to the tangent thereof, shall be a minimum of 330 feet for an **oil** well. 19.15.16.15(C)(1)(b) NMAC governs the first and last take point of a horizontal well shall be no closer than 100 feet for a well within the horizontal plane, to any outer boundary of the horizontal spacing unit.

The request to deviate from an orthodox location has met all requirements of 19.15.16.15 (C)(5)(a) NMAC. It is understood that you are seeking this exception in order to create a non-standard location, comprised of First and Last Take Points referenced above within the described Horizontal Spacing Unit.

This well's completed interval is as close as 25 feet to the southern edge of the horizontal spacing unit. Encroachment will impact the following tracts.

Section 33, encroachment to the NW/4 SW/4

The Division understands you have given notice of this application to all operators or owners who are "affected persons," as defined in 19.15.2.7(A)(8) NMAC, in all adjoining units towards which the proposed location encroaches.

Division understands you are seeking this unorthodox location for the greatest recovery of reserves within the unit and to prevent waste within the Wolfcamp formation underlying W/2 NW/4 Section 33, W/2 W/2 Section 28 and the W/2 SW/4 Section 21.

Your application has been filed under 19.15.16.15(C)(6) NMAC, 19.15.15.13 NMAC and 19.15.4.12 (A)(2) NMAC.

Per 19.15.15.13 (B) NMAC, **Division approves this unorthodox location.**

Reference this NSL order number on the As Drilled C-102 submitted with the Authorization to Transport, to place this well into production.

Dear Director Chang /OCD Engineering Bureau:

Pursuant to Division rules 19.15.16.15(C)(6) and 19.15.15.13 NMAC, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. ("Chevron") (OGRID No. 4323) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location ("NSL") for its ZN 33 21 Federal Com 601H well (API No. 30-025-54932) (the "Well") located in th W/2NW/4 of Section 33, the W/2W/2 of Section 28, and the W/2SW/4 of Section 21, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and will be in the Antelope Ridge; Wolfcamp pool (Pool Codes 2220). A C-102 for the Well is attached as Exhibit A.

The horizontal spacing unit to which the Well will be dedicated is described as:

Description	Acres	Pool	Pool Code
W/2NW/4 of Section 33; W/2W/2 of Section 28; W/2SW/4 of Section 21	320	Antelope Ridge; Wolfcamp	2220

The Antelope Ridge; Wolfcamp Pool is an oil pool subject to the state-wide rules, which establish a 100' setback requirement for the first and last take points of a well to the outer boundary of the spacing unit. The Well's **first take point** will be closer than 100' from the outer boundary of the spacing unit, which requires an NSL approval. As shown on Exhibit A, this is a horizontal well that will be drilled as follows:

- Surface Hole Location: 1761' FSL & 2207' FWL (Unit K) of Section 33-T23S-R34E;
- Bottom Hole Location: 2615' FSL & 550' FWL (Unit L) of Section 21-T23S-R34E;
- First Take Point: 2615' FNL & 550' FWL (Unit E) of Section 33-T23S-R34E;
- Last Take Point: 2540' FSL & 550' FWL (Unit L) of Section 21-T23S-R34E.

Chevron has included as Exhibit B a letter explaining why this application is needed. Chevron also provides a map of the area, attached as Exhibit C, which shows the tracts upon which the unorthodox location will encroach.

As discussed above, the Well's **first take point** will be closer than 100' from the outer boundary of the spacing unit. *See* Exhibit A (C-102). The unorthodox location will encroach towards the SW/4 of Section 33, Township 23 South, Range 34 East.

Chevron is the operator and owns 100% of the working interest in SW/4 of Section 33, Township 23 South, Range 34 East. Pursuant to Rule 19.15.4.12(A)(2) and Rule 19.15.2.7(A)(3), Chevron is thus providing notice to the New Mexico State Land Office ("SLO") and the Bureau of Land Management ("BLM"). Proof of mailing along with a copy of the letter sent to the SLO and the BLM are included in Exhibit D. Chevron's landman has provided a letter confirming the ownership in the SW/4 of Section 33, Township 23 South, Range 34 East, which is included as Exhibit E.
