<u>APPLICANT</u>

CASE NO. 20780

Application of Salt Creek Midstream, LLC, for authorization to drill, complete and operate an acid gas injection well at the Ameredev South Gas Processing Facility in Lea County, New Mexico.

OPPONENT NEW MEXICO STATE LAND OFFICE

The State Land Office ("SLO") is concerned with the proximity of the proposed AGI well site to State Trust Lands and Minerals. SLO records indicate nearby production in the requested injection zone, there are additional horizontal wells in the area that penetrate the injection zone, and there are concerns about potential communication with the Capitan Reef. Permitting Applicant's AGI poses a health and safety threat to personnel operating producing wells in proximity of the AGI and, moreover, the requested AGI may cause waste if acid gas migrates into producing wells thereby causing waste in the Delaware and other deeper formations. Therefore, SLO requests Applicant's AGI be denied as requested in Applicant's applicant's application or, in the alternative, Applicant drill its AGI to the Devonian.
