## **APPLICATION**

Caza Petroleum, LLC applies for an order pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Section 25 and the E/2 of Section 36, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the E/2 of Section 36 and has the right to drill a well or wells thereon.
  - 2. Applicant proposes to drill the following Wells:
    - (a) The Comanche 25-36 Federal State #3H to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring with the first take point in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 25 and the last take point in the SW/4SE/4 of Section 36; and
    - (b) The Comanche 25-36 Federal State #4H to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring with the first take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 25 and the last take point in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 36.
- 3. Applicant in good faith has sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation in the E/2 of Section 27 and the E/2 of Section 34for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the Wells or to otherwise commit their interests to the

Wells, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the E/2 of Section 27 and the E/2 of Section 34, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §§70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the E/2 of Section 27 and the E/2 of Section 34will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

**WHEREFORE**, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

A. Pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the E/2 of Section 27 and the E/2 of Section 34;

B. Designating Caza Operating, LLCas operator of the Wells;

C. Considering the cost of drilling, completing, and equipping the Wells and allocating the cost thereof among the wells' working interest owners;

D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and

E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, and equipping the wells in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.
