As applied for in Case No. 21549, Order No. R-21092-A granted Novo's request for a standard 635.4-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 of Section 13, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, and Lots 1-2, E/2 NW/4 and the NE/4 (N/2 equivalent) of irregular Section 18, all in Township 23 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County/

7. Due to COVID, Novo requests a one-year extension of time to drill the initial well under the Order, until <u>December 24, 2022</u>.

3. I am familiar with the applications filed by Novo in **Case Nos. 22350** and **22351**, and I am familiar with the status of the lands in the subject area.

4. None of the pooled parties has indicated opposition to this extension application, and therefore I do not expect any opposition at the hearing

5. Novo Exhibit C-1 is a project locator map for the enlarged standard horizontal spacing units applied for in Case Nos. 22350 and 22351.

6. Novo Exhibit C-1 also shows the units in relation to the surrounding acreage.

In both of these cases, Novo initially applied for and received approval of standard horizontal spacing units for the development of one-mile horizontal wells. 8. None of the uncommitted parties has indicated opposition to these pooling applications, and I do not expect any opposition at the hearing to presenting these cases by affidavits.
