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APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

In Case No. 22403, Devon seeks an order (1) establishing a standard 800-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the NW/4 of Section 23 and the W/2 of Sections 14 and 11, Township 26 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and (2) pooling

all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation, designated as an oil pool, underlying said unit. Devon proposes to dedicate the unit to its Muskie 23-11 Fed Com 11H Well, Muskie 23-11 Fed Com 12H Well, and Muskie 23-11 Fed Com 13H Well.

Devon proposes the **Muskie 23-11 Fed Com 11H Well**, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 NW/4 (Unit E) of Section 23 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 11.

Devon proposes the **Muskie 23-11 Fed Com 12H Well**, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 NW/4 (Unit F) of Section 23 to a bottom hole location approximately at the midpoint between the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) and the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 11. The **Muskie 23-11 Fed Com 12H Well** is the proximity well positioned in the unit to allow for the use of proximity tracts in order to create the larger unit covering the NW/4 of Section 23, and the W/2 of Sections 14 and 11.

Devon proposes the **Muskie 23-11 Fed Com 13H Well**, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 NW/4 (Unit F) of Section 23 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 11.
