## COG OPERATING LLC'S RESPONSE TO THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S INQUIRY

- 1. In the above-referenced case, COG seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Corral Canyon; Bone Spring, South Pool (13354) within the Bone Spring formation underlying a 280-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2W/2 of Section 5, the E/2NW/4 and NE/4SW/4 of 8, Township 26 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico and seeks to dedicate this unit to its Hambone Federal Com #505H well.
- 2. The above-referenced case was heard and taken under advisement at the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") hearing held on January 6, 2022. During the hearing, the Division expressed concern regarding the status of the acreage in the SE/4SW/4 of Section 8.
- 3. COG intends to include and develop the S/2SW/4 of Section 8 within a separate spacing unit. Accordingly, the SE/4SW/4 of Section 8 will not be stranded.
