STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying an 1820.97-acre non-standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of lots 1-4, E/2W/2, and E/2 (all) of Section 31, Lots 1-4, N/2, and N/2S/2 (all) of Section 32, and Lots 1-4, N/2, and N/2S/2 (all) of Section 33, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to:

- (a) the Pavo Macho 31/33 B3DA Fed. Com. Well No. 2H, with a first take point in Lot 1 of Section 31 and a last take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 33;
- (b) the Pavo Macho 31/33 B3EH Fed. Com. Well No. 2H, with a first take point in Lot 2 of Section 31 and a last take point in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 33;
- (c) the Pavo Macho 31/33 B3LI Fed. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in Lot 3 of Section 31 and a last take point in the NE/4SE/4, of Section 33; and

(d) the Pavo Macho 31/33 B3MP Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in Lot 4 of Section 31 and a last take point in the SE/4SE/4, of Section 33.
