STATEMENT OF THE CASES

In **Case No. 24959**, Permian Resources applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests from the top of the Bone Spring formation to the base of the Second Bone Spring interval underlying a 320-acre, more or less, standard, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 N/2 of Sections 24 and 23, Township 20 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the **Bondi 24 Fed Com 121H** well, which will be drilled from a surface hole location in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 24 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NW/4

(Unit D) of Section 23. Due to a depth severance, Applicant seeks to pool uncommitted interests from the top of the Bone Spring formation to the base of the Second Bone Spring interval at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 7,624' MD as observed on the Government AA #1 well log (API No. 30-015- 21286).

In **Case No. 24960**, Permian Resources applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests from the top of the Bone Spring formation to the base of the Second Bone Spring interval underlying a 320-acre, more or less, standard, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2 N/2 of Sections 24 and 23, Township 20 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the **Bondi 24 Fed Com 122H** well, which will be drilled from a surface hole location in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 24 to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 NW/4 (Unit E) of Section 23. Due to a depth severance, Applicant seeks to pool uncommitted interests from the top of the Bone Spring formation to the base of the Second Bone Spring interval at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 7,624' MD as observed on the Government AA #1 well log (API No. 30-015- 21286).

In **Case No. 24961**, Permian Resources applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests from the top of the Bone Spring formation to the base of the Second Bone Spring interval underlying a 320-acre, more or less, standard, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 S/2 of Sections 24 and 23, Township 20 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the **Bondi 24 Fed Com 123H** well, which will be drilled from a surface hole location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 24 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 23. Due to a depth severance, Applicant seeks to pool uncommitted interests from the top of the Bone Spring formation to the base of the Second Bone Spring interval at a

stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 7,624' MD as observed on the Government AA #1 well log (API No. 30-015- 21286).

In **Case No. 24962**, Permian Resources applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests from the top of the Bone Spring formation to the base of the Second Bone Spring interval underlying a 320-acre, more or less, standard, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2 S/2 of Sections 24 and 23, Township 20 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the **Bondi 24 Fed Com 124H** well, which will be drilled from a surface hole location in the NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 24 to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 23. Due to a depth severance, Applicant seeks to pool uncommitted interests from the top of the Bone Spring formation to the base of the Second Bone Spring interval at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 7,624' MD as observed on the Government AA #1 well log (API No. 30-015- 21286).

The completed intervals of the wells will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the costs, the designation of Applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells. The wells are located approximately 10.5 miles northeast of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
