ORDER PARTIALLY AMENDING THE COMMISSION'S JULY 2, 2024 ORDER WITH RESPECT TO THE SCOPE OF THE HEARING

This matter, having come before the Chairman of the Oil Conservation Commission

("OCC") sua sponte to amend its previous order of July 2, 2024 ("the Order") regarding the scope

of this hearing, and the Commission, being duly advised, and further noting verbal consent of the

parties to said amendment during the hearing on February 28, 2025, hereby orders that paragraph 2

of the Order be amended to read as follows:

"2. At said hearing the parties shall submit all evidence, testimony and legal argument on whether (1) the granting of the above captioned applications by Goodnight would impair correlative rights or cause waste in the Eunice Monument South Unit ("EMSU") pursuant to Section 70-2-11, or (2) the granting of the applications by Empire would prevent the impairment of correlative rights or waste in the EMSU pursuant to Section 70-2-11, or (3) the granting or denial of any of these applications would cause the disposition of produced water in violation of the federal Safe Drinking Water Act or contrary to public health, the environment and fresh water resources pursuant to Section 70-2-12(B)(15)."
