MRC Permian Company (“MRC” or “Applicant”), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to amend Order R-21697 to add an additional record title owner to the pooling order. In support of its application, MRC states:

1. Order R-21697 was issued in Case 21108 and pooled uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation [Getty; Bone Spring (27470)] underlying the N/2 S/2 of Sections 14 and 15, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. This standard 320-acre horizontal well spacing unit is currently dedicated to the **Ted 1514 Fed Com 123H** well.


2. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain a signature on the federal communitization agreement from a record title owner.

3. Pooling this additional record title owner in the spacing unit is necessary to obtain approval of the communitization agreement from the Bureau of Land Management, to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on August 7, 2025, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order pooling this additional record title owner under the terms of Order R-21697.
