STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT:

In Case No. 25432, Chevron seeks an order from the Division pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a 640-acre, more or less, Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit comprised of W/2 of Sections 16 and 21, Township 25 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in the Purple Sage Wolfcamp Gas Pool (Code 98220). This spacing unit will be dedicated to the following wells: Weller 21 16 Federal Com 462H and Weller 21 16 Federal Com 463H wells to be horizontally drilled from proposed surface hole locations in the NE/4 SW/4 (Unit K) of Section 21, to proposed bottom hole locations in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 16; and the Weller 21 16 Federal Com 464H and Weller 21 16 Federal Com 465H wells to be horizontally drilled from proposed surface hole locations in the NE/4 SW/4 (Unit K) of Section 21, to proposed bottom hole locations in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 16. The wells will comply with the Division's setback requirements for the Purple Sage Wolfcamp pool. Also to be

considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said wells, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Chevron U.S.A. Inc. as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said wells. The unit is located approximately 10 miles southwest of Malaga, New Mexico.
