Matador Production Company ("Matador" or "Applicant"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to amend pooling Order R-22944 to add additional interest owners to the pooling order. In support of its application, Matador states:

- 1. On October 31, 2023, the Division issued Order R-22944 in Case No. 23671, which pooled the uncommitted interest owners in the Bone Spring formation (Culebra Bluff; Bone Spring, South [15011]) underlying the S/2 S/2 of Section 1 and the S/2 SE/4 of Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. This standard 240-acre overlapping horizontal well spacing unit is currently dedicated to the drilled and producing **Drew Dix Federal Com 114H** (API No. 30-015-54513) and **Drew Dix Federal Com 134H** (API No. 30-015-54551) wells.
- 2. Applicant has discovered additional interest owners in the pooled acreage that were not subject to the pooling proceedings giving rise to Order R-22944.
- 3. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from these additional interest owners.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on September 11, 2025, and, after notice and hearing

as required by law, the Division enter an order pooling these additional interest owners under the terms of Order R-22944.
