## **APPLICATION**

Matador Production Company ("Matador" or "Applicant"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to amend pooling Order R-22461 to add an additional interest owner to the pooling order. In support of its application, Matador states:

- 1. On December 23, 2022, the Division issued Order R-22461 in Case No. 23068, which pooled the uncommitted interest owners in the Bone Spring formation (Getty; Bone Spring [27470]) underlying the S/2 S/2 of Section 15 and the S/2 SW/4 of Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. This standard 240-acre horizontal well spacing unit is currently dedicated to the drilled and producing **Ted 1514 Federal Com 124H** (API No. 30-015-53698) well.
- 2. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain a signature on the federal communitization agreement from a record title owner.
- 3. Pooling this additional record title owner in the spacing unit is necessary to obtain approval of the communitization agreement from the Bureau of Land Management, and to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on September 11, 2025, and, after notice and hearing

as required by law, the Division enter an order pooling this additional record title owner under the terms of Order R-22461.
