APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Under Case No. 25580, MRC seeks an order (a) approving a standard 320-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation ([Airstrip]; Bone Spring [POOL 960]) underlying the W/2 of Section 34, Township 18 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and (b) pooling all uncommitted interests in this acreage. MRC seeks to initially dedicate the spacing unit to the proposed **Art Smith State Com 130H** u-turn well, with a surface hole location in the S/2 SW/4 of Section 27, to a first take point in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 34 and a last take point in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) Section 34. This proposed horizontal

well spacing unit will overlap the following spacing units in the Bone Spring formation with approved pooling orders (permits pending):

- An existing 320-acre spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation underlying the W/2 W/2 of Section 34, T18S-R34E, and the W/2 W/2 of Section 3, T19S-R34E, currently dedicated to the Art Smith State Com 121H, operated by Matador Production Company; and
- An existing 320-acre spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation underlying the E/2 W/2 of Section 34, T18S-R34E, and the E/2 W/2 of Section 3, T19S-R34E, currently dedicated to the Art Smith State Com 122H, operated by Matador Production.

The completed interval for the well will comply with statewide setbacks for oil wells. MRC has sought but been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from all interest owners in the subject spacing units.
