


Full Scale Development Plan Joker, Bane, Riddler





- Upper Third Bone Spring plugs have higher core water saturations and low oil saturations




Stratigraphic Cross-Section A-A' Joker 5-8 Fed Com Wolfcamp




Regional View – 32 WFMP XY Wells
