APPLICATION

Matador Production Company ("Matador" or "Applicant"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") to amend pooling Order R-21267, as amended, to add an additional record title owner to the pooling order. In support of its application, Matador states:

- 1. On April 28, 2020 the Division issued Order R-21267 (the "Order") in Case No. 20904 pooling uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation (Getty; Bone Spring [27470]) underlying the N/2 N/2 of Sections 21 and 22, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. This standard 320-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit is currently dedicated to the drilled and producing **Michael K 21 22 Federal Com 121H** well (API No. 30-015-53689).
- 2. Subsequently, on May 26, 2021 the Division issued Order R-21267-A in Case No. 21812 amending the Order to conform to the Division's amended order template and to extend the deadline to commence drilling by one year. Then, on January 26, 2022, the Division issued Order R-21267-B in Case No. 22301 to add a newly identified pooled party. Finally, on December 5, 2022 the Division issued Order R-21267-C in Case No. 22706 to extend the drilling deadline under the Order for good cause.

- 3. Since the issuance of amended Order R-21267-C, Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain signature on the federal communitization agreement from a record title owner.
- 4. Pooling this additional record title owner in the spacing unit is necessary to obtain approval of the communitization agreement from the Bureau of Land Management, and to prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on November 13, 2025, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order pooling this additional record title owner under the terms of Order R-21267, as amended.
