Permian Resources Operating, LLC ("Permian Resources" or "Applicant") submits its Consolidated Pre-Hearing Statement pursuant to the rules of the Oil Conservation Division.

STATEMENT OF THE CASES

In **Case No. 25664**, Permian Resources applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Avalon formation and the Third Bone Spring interval of the Bone Spring formation underlying a 482.26- acre, more or less, standard, overlapping horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2 W/2 of irregular Section 5 and the W/2 W/2 of Sections 8 and 17, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the **Casa Bonita 5 State**

Com 601H well (“Well”), which will produce from a first take point in the NW/4 NW/4 (Lot 4) of Section 5 to a last take point in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 17.

Multiple depth severances exist within the Unit. Accordingly, Applicant seeks to pool uncommitted interests from the top of the Avalon formation, at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 8,724’ TVD, to the base of the Avalon, at a stratigraphic equivalent of 9,366’ TVD, and from the top of the Third Bone Spring interval, at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 10,344’ TVD, to the base of the Third Bone Spring interval, at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 10,956’ TVD, as observed on the San Simon 32-A State Com #1 well log (API No. 30-025-27306). The unit will partially overlap with the following spacing units: the Casa Bonita 5 State Com #301H (API No. 30-025-54132), which produces from the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136); the Casa Bonita 32 State Com #121H (API No. 30-025-52199) well, which produces from the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136); the Antler 17 State 2BS #003H (API No. 30-025-44143) well, which produces from the Rock Lake; Bone Spring Pool (Code 52766); and the Casa Bonita 32 State Com #301H (API No. 30-025-54132) well, which produces from both the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136) and Rock Lake; Bone Spring Pool (Code 52766).

In **Case No. 25665**, Permian Resources applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Avalon formation and the Third Bone Spring interval of the Bone Spring formation underlying a 482.19- acre, more or less, standard, overlapping horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of irregular Section 5 and the E/2 W/2 of Sections 8 and 17, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the **Casa Bonita 5 State Com 602H** well, which will produce from a first take point in the NE/4 NW/4 (Lot 3) of Section 5 to a last take point in the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 17.

Multiple depth severances exist within the Unit. Accordingly, Applicant seeks to pool uncommitted interests from the top of the Avalon formation, at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 8,724' TVD, to the base of the Avalon, at a stratigraphic equivalent of 9,366' TVD, and from the top of the Third Bone Spring interval, at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 10,344' TVD, to the base of the Third Bone Spring interval, at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 10,956' TVD, as observed on the San Simon 32-A State Com #1 well log (API No. 30-025-27306). The unit will partially overlap with the following spacing units: the Antler 17 State 1BS #002H (API No. 30-025-44142) well, which produces from the Rock Lake; Bone Spring Pool (Code 52766); the Butter Stotch 17 State Com #122H (API No. 30-025-52196) well, which produces from both the Rock Lake; Bone Spring Pool (Code 52766) and the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136); Soursop 5 State Com #002H (API No. 30-025-42583) well, which produces from the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136); and Casa Bonita 5 State com #302H (API No. 30-025-54151) well, which produces from the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136).

In **Case No. 25666**, Permian Resources applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Avalon formation and the Third Bone Spring interval of the Bone Spring formation underlying a 482.11- acre, more or less, standard, overlapping horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2 E/2 of irregular Section 5 and the W/2 E/2 of Sections 8 and 17, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the **Casa Bonita 5 State Com 603H** well, which will produce from a first take point in the NW/4 NE/4 (Lot 2) of Section 5 to a last take point in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 17.

Multiple depth severances exist within the Unit. Accordingly, Applicant seeks to pool uncommitted interests from the top of the Avalon formation, at a stratigraphic equivalent of

approximately 8,724' TVD, to the base of the Avalon, at a stratigraphic equivalent of 9,366' TVD, and from the top of the Third Bone Spring interval, at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 10,344' TVD, to the base of the Third Bone Spring interval, at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 10,956' TVD, as observed on the San Simon 32-A State Com #1 well log (API No. 30-025-27306). The unit will partially overlap with the following spacing units: the Casa Bonita 8 State Com #123H (API No. 30-025-52486) well, which produces from the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136); the Butter Stotch 8 State Com #123H (API No. 30-025-52196) well, which produces from the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136); and Casa Bonita 5 State Com #303H (API No. 30-025-54262) well, which produces from the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136).

In **Case No. 25668**, Permian Resources applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Avalon formation and the Third Bone Spring interval of the Bone Spring formation underlying a 482.04- acre, more or less, standard, overlapping horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 E/2 of irregular Section 5 and the E/2 E/2 of Sections 8 and 17, Township 22 South, Range 35 East, Lea County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the **Casa Bonita 5 State Com 604H** and the **Casa Bonita 5 State Com 104H** wells ("Wells"), which will produce from first take points in the NE/4 NE/4 (Lot 1) of Section 5 to last take points in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 17.

Multiple depth severances exist within the Unit. Accordingly, Applicant seeks to pool uncommitted interests from the top of the Avalon formation, at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 8,724' TVD, to the base of the Avalon, at a stratigraphic equivalent of 9,366' TVD, and from the top of the Third Bone Spring interval, at a stratigraphic equivalent of approximately 10,344' TVD, to the base of the Third Bone Spring interval, at a stratigraphic equivalent of

approximately 10,956' TVD, as observed on the San Simon 32-A State Com #1 well log (API No. 30-025-27306). The unit will partially overlap with the following spacing units: the Casa Bonita 8 State Com #124H (API No. 30-025-52487) well, which produces from the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136); the Butter Stotch 8 State Com #124H (API No. 30-025-52485) well, which produces from the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136); and Casa Bonita 5 State Com #304H (API No. 30-025-54263) well, which produces from the WC-025 G-07 S223505N Pool (Code 98136).

The completed intervals of the Casa Bonita wells will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the costs, the designation of Applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells.
