APPLICATION

Read & Stevens, Inc. ("Applicant"), through undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17, for an order (1) approving a standard 480-acre, more or less, overlapping horizontal well spacing unit in a portion of the Bone Spring formation, from the top of the Bone Spring formation to the base of the First Bone Spring, underlying the N/2 N/2 of Sections 14, 15, and 16, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and (2) pooling all uncommitted interests in this acreage. In support of its application, Applicant states:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the proposed horizontal spacing unit and has the right to drill thereon.

Applicant seeks to designate Permian Resources Operating, LLC (OGRID No.
 372165) as the operator of the proposed horizontal spacing unit.

3. Applicant seeks to initially dedicate the above-referenced horizontal spacing unit to the proposed **Slim Jim 14-15 Federal Com 111H** well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 14, to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 16.

- 4. This proposed horizontal well spacing unit will overlap the following spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation:
 - An existing 160-acre horizontal spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation underlying the N/2 N/2 of Section 15, T18S-R31E, currently dedicated to the Tamano 15 AD Federal Com 1H (API No. 30-015-40868), operated by Mewbourne Oil Company.
- 5. An ownership depth severance exists in the Bone Spring formation within the proposed horizontal well spacing unit. Accordingly, Permian seeks to pool only a portion of the Bone Spring formation, measured from the top of the Bone Spring formation, seen at 6,040 feet total vertical depth, to the stratigraphic equivalent of the base of the First Bone Spring, as seen at 7,955 feet total vertical beneath the surface, as shown in that certain Dual Lateralog, Micro Laterlog, Gamma Ray well log in the Tamano 15 Fed Com 2 (API No. 30-015-33398), located in Section 15, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. Permian will provide notice of this hearing to the vertical offset parties within the pool who are not subject to this pooling application.
- 6. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from all interest owners in the subject spacing unit.
- 7. The pooling of interests will allow Applicant to obtain a just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste, and will protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on October 9, 2025, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order:

A. Approving the proposed overlapping spacing unit and pooling all uncommitted interests therein;

- В. Designating Permian Resources Operating, LLC as operator of this overlapping horizontal spacing unit and the horizontal well to be drilled thereon;
- C. Authorizing Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, completing, and equipping the well;
- D. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and
- E. Imposing a 200% charge for the risk assumed by Applicant in drilling and completing the well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the well.

SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF SEAN JOHNSON

- My name is Sean Johnson. I work for Permian Resources Operating, LLC 1. ("Permian") as the New Mexico Land Manager. Permian is the proposed designated operator on behalf of Read & Stevens, Inc.
- 2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") as an expert witness in petroleum land matters. My credentials as a petroleum landman have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.
- 3. I am familiar with the applications filed by Read & Stevens, Inc. and Permian Resources Operating, LLC (collectively "Permian" or "Applicant") in this case, and I am familiar with the status of the lands in the subject area.
- In Case No. 25670, Permian seeks order (1) approving a standard 480-acre, more 4. or less, overlapping horizontal well spacing unit in a portion of the Bone Spring formation, from the top of the Bone Spring formation to the base of the First Bone Spring, underlying the N/2 N/2 of Sections 14, 15, and 16, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and (2) pooling all uncommitted interests in this acreage, and initially dedicate this spacing unit to the proposed Slim Jim 14-15 Federal Com 111H well, to be horizontally drilled

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from a surface location in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 14, to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 16.

- 5. This proposed horizontal well spacing unit will overlap the following spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation:
 - An existing 160-acre horizontal spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation underlying the N/2 N/2 of Section 15, T18S-R31E, currently dedicated to the Tamano 15 AD Federal Com 1H (API No. 30-015-40868), operated by Mewbourne Oil Company.
- 6. **Permian Exhibit C-1** is a diagram depicting the newly proposed spacing unit, in relation to Mewbourne Oil Company's existing spacing unit. Permian provided notice to Mewbourne Oil Company, operator of the Tamano 15 AD Federal 1H and the Bureau of Land Management ("BLM") since federal lands are involved. A sample copy of the notice, and mailing report, is included in Permian Exhibit E.
- 7. An ownership depth severance exists in the Bone Spring formation within the proposed horizontal well spacing unit. Accordingly, Permian seeks to pool only a portion of the Bone Spring formation, measured from the top of the Bone Spring formation, seen at 6,040 feet total vertical depth, to the stratigraphic equivalent of the base of the First Bone Spring, as seen at 7,955 feet total vertical beneath the surface, as shown in that certain Dual Lateralog, Micro Laterlog, Gamma Ray well log in the Tamano 15 Fed Com 2 (API No. 30-015-33398), located in Section 15, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. Permian has provided notice of this hearing to the vertical offset parties where the depths severances occur within the pool who are not subject to this pooling application. *See* Permian Exhibit E.
- 8. **Permian Exhibit C-2** contains a C-102 for the proposed well. This form demonstrates that the completed interval for the well will comply with statewide setbacks for oil wells. The well is dedicated to the Bone Spring formation Tamano; Bone Spring [58040].

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- 9. **Permian Exhibit C-3** identifies the tracts of land comprising the proposed horizontal spacing units, the ownership interests in each tract, and a recapitulation of the ownership. The interest owners that Permian seeks to pool are highlighted in yellow. The subject acreage that Permian seeks to pool is comprised of state and federal leases.
- 10. **Permian C-4** contains a sample of the well proposal letter and AFEs for the well that was sent to owners with a working interest. The costs reflected in the AFEs are consistent with what Permian and other operators have incurred for drilling similar horizontal wells in the area in this formation.
- 11. Permian requests that the overhead and administrative costs for drilling and producing the proposed well be set at \$10,000 per month while drilling and \$1,000 per month while producing. These costs are consistent with what other operators are charging in this area for similar wells.
- 12. **Permian Exhibit C-5** contains a general summary of the contacts with the uncommitted interest owners. As indicated in the exhibit, Permian has made a good faith effort to locate and has had communications with the majority of the parties that it seeks to pool in this case in an effort to reach voluntary joinder. In my opinion, Permian has undertaken good faith efforts to reach an agreement with the uncommitted interest owners.
- 13. Permian has provided the law firm of Holland & Hart LLP with the names and addresses of the parties that Permian seeks to pool and instructed that they be notified of this hearing. Permian has conducted a diligent search of all public records in the county where the property is located, reviewed telephone directories, and conducted computer searches to locate contact information for each interest owner.

- 14. **Permian Exhibits C-1 through C-5** were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.
- 15. I affirm under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of New Mexico that the foregoing statements are true and correct. I understand that this self-affirmed statement will be used as written testimony in this case. This statement is made on the date next to my signature below.

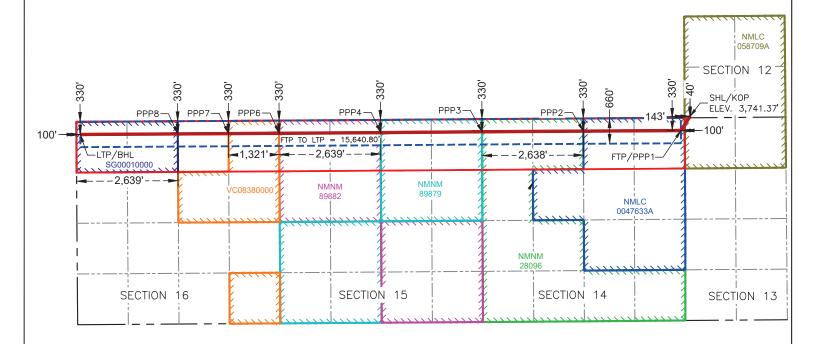

- My name is Chris Cantin. I work for Permian Resources Operating, LLC ("Permian") as a Geologist.
- 2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") as an expert witness in petroleum geology matters. My credentials as a petroleum geologist have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.
- 3. I am familiar with the application filed by Read & Stevens, Inc. and Permian Resources Operating, LLC (collectively "Permian" or "Applicant") in this case, and I have conducted a geologic study of the lands in the subject area.
- 4. Permian has targeted a portion of the Bone Spring formation, from the top of the Bone Spring formation to the base of the First Bone Spring, in this case.
- 5. **Permian Exhibit D-1** is a regional locator map that identifies the Slim Jim project area, in proximity to the Capitan Reef within the Delaware Basin, for the Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit that is the subject of this application.
- 6. **Permian Exhibit D-2** is a cross-section location map for the proposed horizontal spacing unit within the Bone Spring formation. The approximate location of the proposed unit is outlined in blue. Existing producing wells in the targeted interval are represented by solid lines.

This map identifies the cross-section running from A-A' with the cross-section well names and a black line in proximity to the proposed well. This map also identifies the Tamano 15 Fed Com #2 (API # 30-015-33398).

- 7. **Permian Exhibit D-3** is a subsea structure map that I prepared for the interval within the Bone Spring formation, with a contour interval of 50 feet. The structure map shows the Bone Spring gently dipping to the southeast. The Bone Spring structure appears consistent across the wellbore path. I do not observe any faulting, pinchouts, or other geologic impediments in the spacing unit. This map also shows the relative location of the proposed well as a dashed green line, as well as the offset producers as solid green lines.
- 8. **Permian Exhibit D-4** is a stratigraphic cross-section that I prepared displaying open-hole logs run over the Bone Spring from the representative wells denoted from A to A'. For each well in the cross-section, the exhibit shows the following logs: gamma ray, resistivity, and porosity. The target interval is labeled and marked with a dashed line. The logs in the cross-section demonstrate that the interval is continuous across the entire spacing unit.
- 9. **Permian Exhibit D-5** is a type log for the Tamano 15 Fed Com #2 (API # 30-015-33398), which also identifies the depth severance in relation to the portion of the Bone Spring that Permian seeks to pool in this case.
- 10. **Permian Exhibit D-6** is a depth severance diagram for this application, showing the depth severance in the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 14.
- 11. In my opinion, laydown orientation of the proposed well is the appropriate orientation for horizontal well development in this area because it is near perpendicular to the maximum horizontal stress of the area.

- 12. Based on my geologic study, the Bone Spring formation underlying the subject area is suitable for development by horizontal wells and the acreage comprising the proposed spacing unit will contribute more-or-less equally to the production from the wellbores. I have not identified any geologic impediments to drilling horizontal wells in the area of the spacing unit proposed.
- 13. In my opinion, horizontal drilling will be the most efficient method to develop this acreage, to prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, and to result in the greatest ultimate recovery, and that approving Read & Stevens's application will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste, and protection of correlative rights.
- 14. **Permian Exhibits D-1 through D-6** were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.

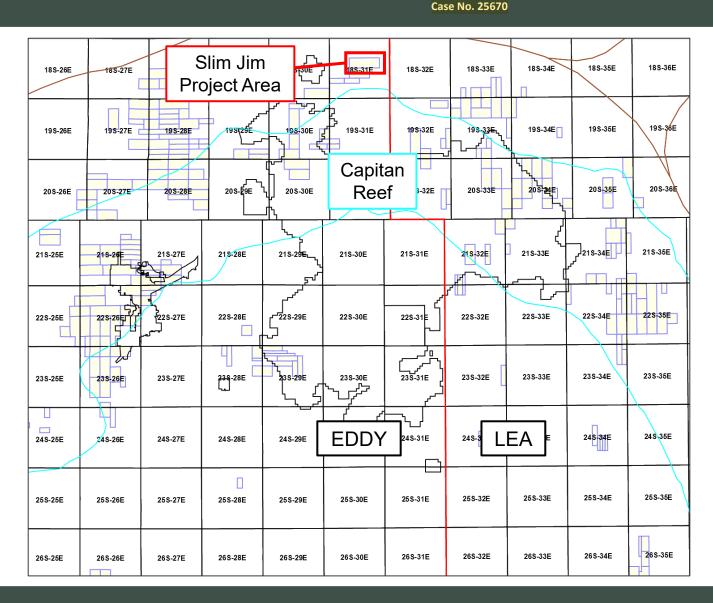

Regional Locator Map Slim Jim 14-15 Fed Com



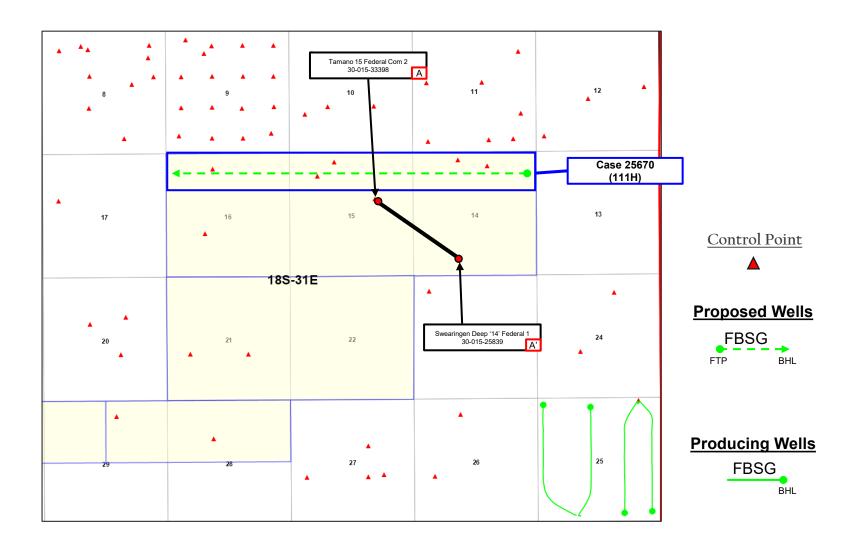

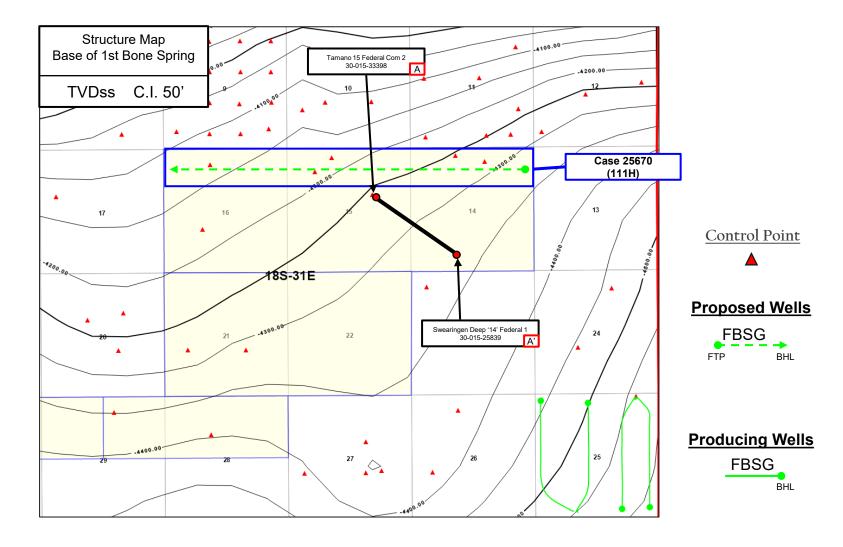

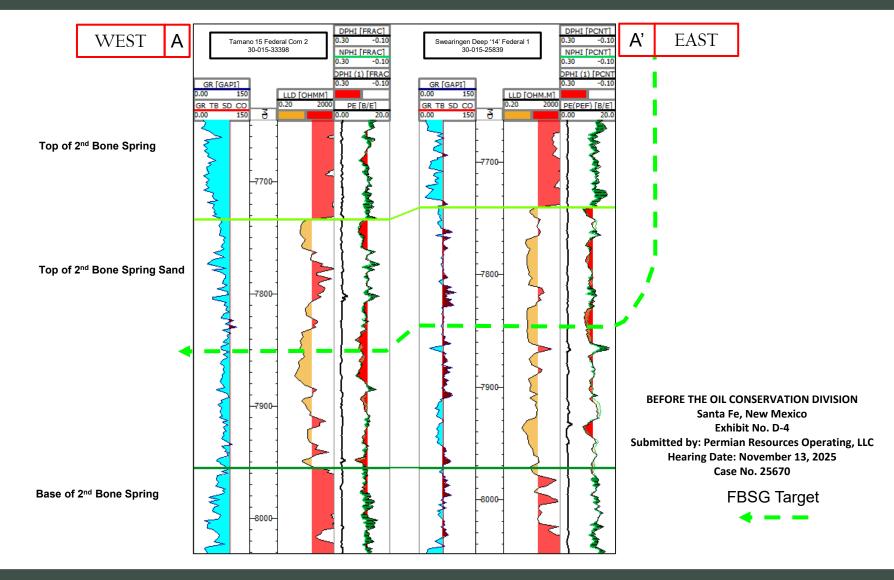
Base of Bone Spring – Structure Map Slim Jim 14-15 Fed Com Fed Com



Stratigraphic Cross-Section A-A' Slim Jim DSU Targets

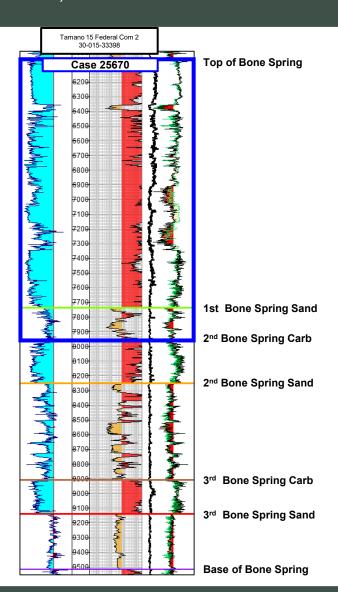
