APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

In this case, Coterra seeks an extension of time for drilling the wells under Order No. R-23452 in case number 24544. The Unit is composed of All of Sections 25 and 36, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Order No. R-23452 pooled the uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation and dedicated the Unit to the proposed initial wells consisting of the **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #301H** (API No. 30-25-52842), **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #302H** (API No. 30-25-52843), **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #303H** (API No. 30-25-54153), **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #304H** (API No. 30-25-54154), **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #501H** (API No. 30-25-52844), **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #502H** (API No. API No. 30-25-52845), **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #503H** (API No. API No. 30-25-54155), **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com 513H Well** (API No. 30-025-54156 *formerly named the Royal Oak 25 Fed Com 504H Well*), **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #511 Well** (API No. 30-025-52846) *formerly named the Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #601H Well*, **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #602H** (API No. API No. 30-25-52847), **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #512H Well** (API No. 30-025-54157) *formerly named the Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #603H Well*, and **Royal Oak 25 Fed Com #604H Well** (API No. 30-025-54158).

There is good cause for Applicant's request for an extension of time to drill.

The wells and lands are located approximately 28 miles west from Hobbs, New Mexico.
