## **APPLICATION**

MRC Permian Company ("MRC" or "Applicant"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to extend the drilling deadline under compulsory pooling Order No. R-23647 ("Pooling Order"). In support of its application, MRC states:

- 1. On January 15, 2025, the Division entered Order No. R-23647 in Case No. 25036, which approved a standard 800.29-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit in the Wolfcamp (oil) formation (Hat Mesa; Wolfcamp [96438]) comprised of the W/2 of irregular Section 3 and Section 10, Township 21 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (the "Unit") and pooled the uncommitted mineral interests therein. Matador Production Company (OGRID No. 228937) is the operator under the Pooling Order and the pooled spacing unit is initially dedicated to the proposed **Electra Special 0310 Fed Com 202H** well.
- 2. Good cause exists to extend the deadline to commence drilling the initial well under the Pooling Order.
- 3. Under the Order, Applicant would be required to commence drilling the well by January 16, 2026, and therefore, asks for the deadline to commence drilling the well be extended for a year, to January 16, 2027.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on December 4, 2025, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order extending the time for MRC to commence drilling the proposed initial well under the Order.

**Application of MRC Permian Company to Extend the Drilling Deadline Under Order No. R-23647, Lea County, New Mexico.** Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks a year extension of time for drilling the initial wells under Order No. R-23647. The Unit is a standard 800.29-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit in the Wolfcamp (oil) formation comprised of the W/2 of irregular Section 3 and Section 10, Township 21 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Order No. R-23647 approved the spacing unit and pooled the uncommitted mineral interests in the Wolfcamp (oil) formation and dedicated the Unit to the proposed initial **Electra Special 0310 Fed Com 202H** well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Lot 3 (NE/4 NW/4 equivalent) of irregular Section 3, to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 10. The subject area is located approximately 29 miles northwest of Eunice, New Mexico.
