151 The division should force pool a disjointed section or landmass.

152 You had argued that you own the land in between, and that there's a well already on  
153 it.

154 We asked you if you could find some precedent from our orders.

155 Did you do that?

158 Yeah, but I was not able to find anything.

161 OK.

163 **JM Jaclyn M. McLean** 11:49

164 We're still, you know, pursuing the non standard spacing unit approval  
165 administratively.

166 And I did, you know, look really carefully at the rule.

167 And under the rule.

168 It's standard horizontal spacing units that are required to be one or more contiguous  
169 tracts that the horizontal oil wells completed.

170 And everyone penetrates in an area that is substantially regular.

171 However, the nonstandard horizontal spacing unit portion of the rule is silent and  
172 does not make any mention of regular shapes or contiguous tracts, and I believe that

173 you know it's mubar position that This is why we're asking for a non standard

174 spacing unit because it doesn't fit within.

175 That standard horizontal spacing unit.  
176 And there's no requirement that it be contiguous.

179 OK. And were you also going to submit any corrections or additions to your  
180 evidence?

183 We did.
