OXY USA Inc. (“OXY” or “Applicant”) (OGRID No. 6137), through its undersigned attorneys, files this application with the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17, to amend Order No. R-22683 pooling a non-standard 1,279.16-acre horizontal spacing unit the Wolfcamp formation underlying all of Sections 4 and 9, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico to correct the pool code and vertical limit of the pooled formation. In support of this application, OXY states:

1. Order No. R-22683, issued in Case 23428, pooled a non-standard 1,279.16-acre horizontal spacing unit in the Wolfcamp formation underlying all of Sections 4 and 9, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The non-standard spacing unit was dedicated to the following wells:

3. Additionally, Order No. R-22683 lists the vertical limit for the spacing unit as “Wolfcamp formation.” However, because the subject pool is limited to the upper Wolfcamp, the correct vertical limit should be the “Upper Wolfcamp Formation.”

4. All other provisions of Order No. R-22683 are requested to remain unchanged.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on June 4, 2026, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division amend Order No. R-22683 to correctly list the pool as WC-025 G-09 S233216K; Upr Wolfcamp Pool [98166] and the vertical limit as “Upper Wolfcamp Formation.”


