ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on October 21, 1981, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard I. Stamets.

NOW, on this 18th day of November, 1981, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Sun Oil Company, seeks approval of an unorthodox oil well location 2500 feet from the North line and 1880 feet from the East line of Section 15, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, to test the Yates formation, Northeast Lusk-Yates Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the SW/4 NE/4 of said Section 15 is to be dedicated to the well.
- (4) That a well at said unorthodox location will better enable applicant to produce the oil and gas underlying the proration unit.
- (5) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.
- (6) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable

share of the oil and gas in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That the application of Sun Oil Company for an unorthodox oil well location for the Yates formation is hereby approved for a well to be located at a point 2500 feet from the North line and 1880 feet from the East line of Section 15, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Northeast Lusk-Yates Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (2) That the SW/4 NE/4 of said Section 15 shall be dedicated to the above-described well.
- (3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.


