CASE 34911 Southeastern New Mexico nomenclature case calling for an order for the creation and extension of certain pools in Lea, Rddy and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico.

a) Create a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for San Andres production and designated as the East Brunson-San Andres Pool. The discovery well is Toxaco, Inc., A. H. Blinberry NCP-1 No. 10, located in Unit 9 of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, NMPM. Said pool described as:



Consideration of the allowable production of gas from nine prorated pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico, for December, 1966.

Application of Hannon-Montic-Gray Drilling Corporation for division of an oil pool into two pools and for special rules for each, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks the division of the Puerto Chiquito-Gallup Oil Pool into two separate pools, being the East Puerto Chiquito-Mancoas Oil Pool and the West Puerto Chiquito-Mancoas Oil Pool. Applicant further proposes that the present temporary 160-acre proration units for the Puerto Chiquito-Gallup Oil Pool be made permanent for the proposed East Puerto Chiquito-Mancoas Oil Pool and that temporary pool rules for the proposed West Puerto Chiquito-Mancoas Oil Pool be adopted, said rules to provide for 120-acre proration units in said pool for a period of three years. Applicant seeks an administrative procedure whereby interference tests could be conducted in the proposed West Puerto Chiquito-Mancoas Oil Pool, including a provision for allowable transfer among wells.
