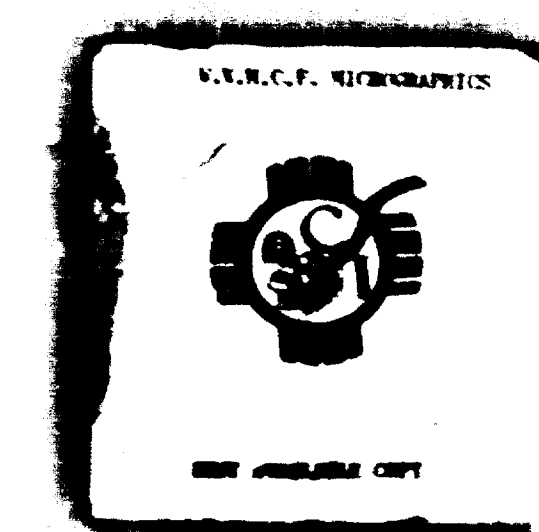
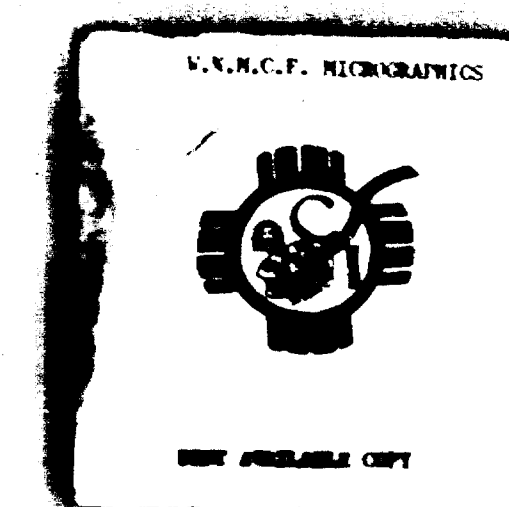
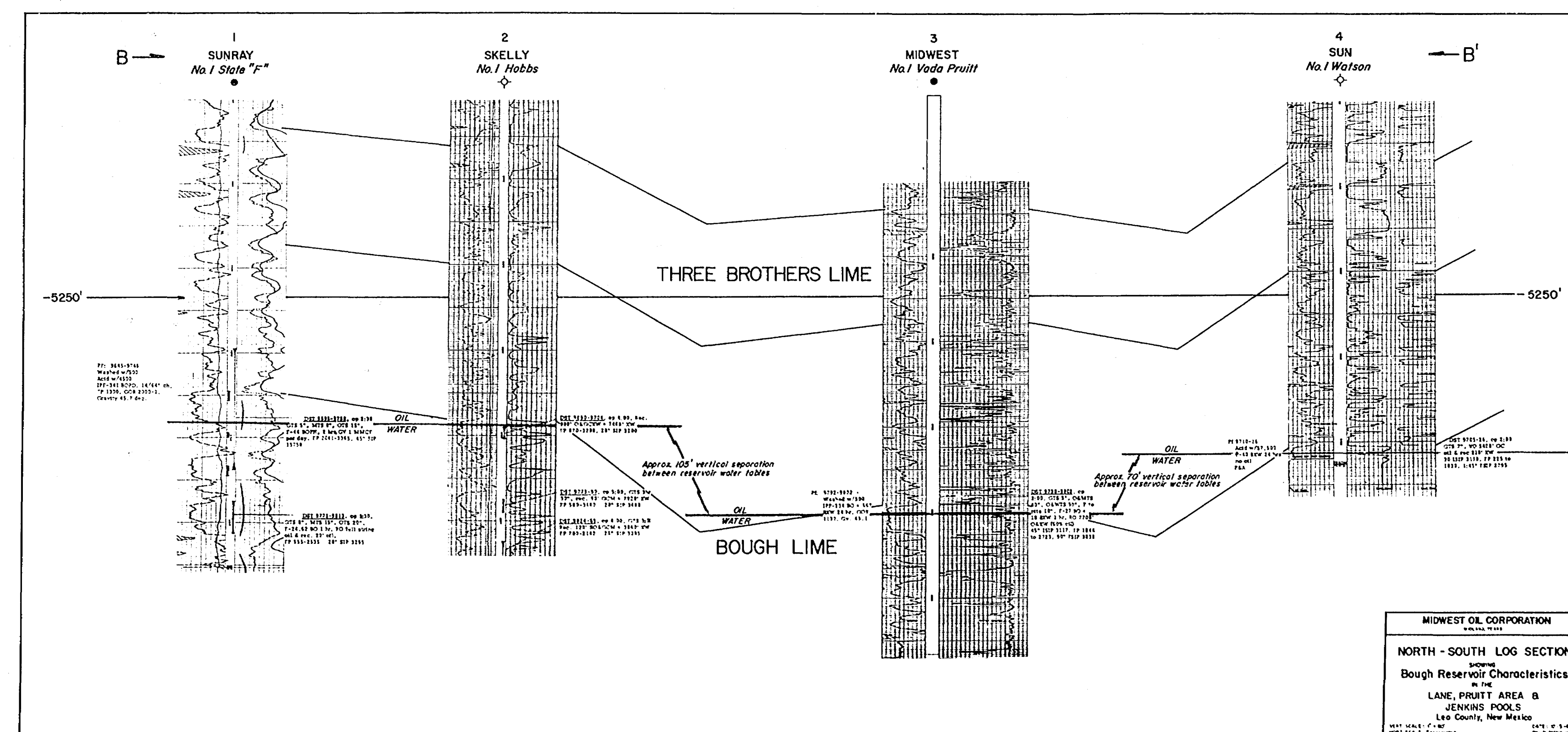

ALLOWABLE: (1) Consideration of the oil allowable for January, 1967;
(2) Consideration of the allowable production of gas for January, 1967 from thirteen prorate pools in Lea, Eddy, and Roosevelt Counties. Consideration of the allowable production of gas from nine prorate pools in San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico for January, 1967. Presentation of purchaser's nominations for the six-month period beginning February 1, 1967, for that area.

CASE 34721 (De Novo)

Application of Len Mayer for compulsory pooling, Chaves County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 1, Township 8 South, Range 30 East, Chaves County, New Mexico. Upon application of Pan American Petroleum Corporation, this case will be heard De Novo under the provisions of Rule 1220.

CASE 3454 (De Novo)

Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for pool consolidation and extension, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks the consolidation of Four Mile-San Andres Pool and the Penasco-San Andres Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, into one pool, and for vertical extension of said pool to include both the San Andres and Yesso formations.

Upon the request of Yates Petroleum Corporation, and pursuant to the provisions of Rule 1220, Case No. 3454 will be heard De Novo to consider modification of Order No. R-3140 to delete any express or implied requirement that more than one single drilling of casing be set at the top of the pay for wells in the Penasco Draw San Andres-Yesso Pool.

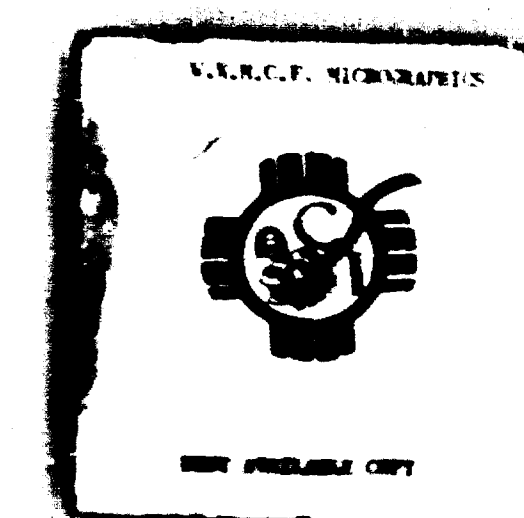

CASE 3503: Southeastern New Mexico nomenclature is being for an order for the creation of one pool and the assignment of an oil discovery allowable therein, and the creation, construction, and extension of certain other pools in Lea, Chaves, and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico:

(a) Create a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Pennsylvania production and designated the Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool, comprising the following-described acreage:

TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPH
SECTION 20: NW/4

Further, for the assignment of approximately 48,960 barrels of oil discovery allowable to the discovery well, Midwest Oil Corporation's Vada Lee Pruitt Well No. 1, located in Unit C of said Section 20.

(b) Create a new pool in Lea County classified as an oil pool for Rose Springs production and designated as the Midway-Rose Springs Pool, and described as:
