- (4) That a well at said unorthodox location resulted from plugging back of a well drilled as an oil well to a deeper horizon.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:



- (3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.


