LEO MILLS PRESSURE MAINTENANCE ASSOCIATION, INC., of El Paso County,
New Mexico, incorporated under the laws of the State of New Mexico, for the pur-
pose of conserving oil and gas and the maintenance of reservoir pressure in the
Leo Mills oil field, and said association being composed of operators owning 188
wells out of a total 375 wells in the entire field; and

"That it is the established practice of Government and State authorities
to encourage the conservation of oil for the prevention of waste; and
whereas the Leo Mills Pressure Maintenance Association, Inc. has been organ-
ized for the prevention of waste and for the extraction of the maximum amount of
oil without waste and has been in operation for a period of 10 months; and

"That it has been found through various engineering studies and surveys that
there is a maximum rate of withdrawal from the wells in the Leo Mills oil field
above which point waste begins with a consequent lessening of ultimate recovery; and
whereas the Leo Mills Pressure Maintenance Association, Inc. feels that it is
their obligation and duty to conserve this vital natural resource through preser-
vation of reservoir pressure. Unless our reservoir pressure is preserved, it will
be necessary, in the near future, to install pumping equipment on a great many wells.
During our present emergency, this equipment is not available and is needed more in
other war efforts.

"We, therefore, respectfully petition the Conservation Commission of New
Mexico that a barrier be called for the operators of leases and wells in the
Leo Mills oil field area in El Paso County, New Mexico at the earliest possible
date in order to prevent evidence for the following proposal:

That a maximum rate of withdrawal of 30 barrels per day per
well be established for the Leo Mills area, including such
allowances, until conditions justify a further increase as
shown by engineering studies.

Gentlemen:

Mr. Fred Fairhead, Secretary and Treasurer of the Loco Hills Pressure Maintenance Association, Artesia, New Mexico, has furnished this office with a copy of a resolution petitioning the Oil Conservation Commission for a hearing on the proposed "that a maximum rate of withdrawal of 30 barrels per day per well be established for the Loco Hills area, including such allowance, until conditions justify a further increase as shown by engineering studies."

This letter is to advise that no objection is offered by this office to the proposed limitation of maximum rate of withdrawal from wells in the Loco Hills area insofar as wells on Government lands are concerned. Such limitation should assist greatly in preventing waste by keeping volume of gas produced with oil more nearly commensurate with the capacity of the pressure plant being operated for the pressure maintenance project. The limitation is not of withdrawal also should tend to lengthen the flowing life of wells and prevent ultimate recovery.

Any approval of a voluntary maximum rate of withdrawal as requested in this case, should provide for the right of the petitioners to request a higher maximum rate at some future time commensurate with the rate then current in adjoining areas where production practices and engineering studies warrant or justify increased withdrawal.
