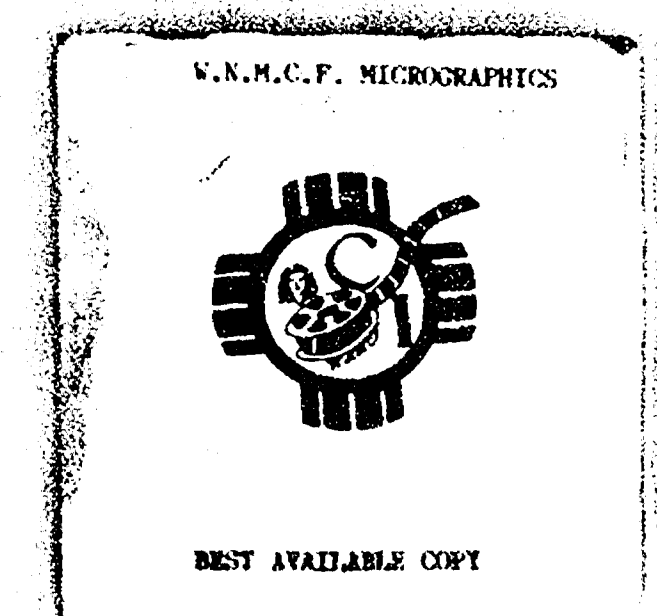

CASE 4675: Southeastern New Mexico nomenclature case calling for an order for the creation, extension, and contraction of certain pools in Lea, Eddy and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico.

(a) Create a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Morrow production and designated as the Eagle Creek-Atoka Gas Pool. The discovery well is the Yates Petroleum Corporation Artesia Airport CP No. 1 located in Unit M of Section 11, Township 17 South, Range 25 East, NMPM. Said pool would comprise:

The discovery well is the Yates Petroleum Corporation Artesia Airport OF No. 1 located in Unit M of Section 11, Township 17 South, Range 25 East, NMN. Said pool would comprise:
