



On December 17, 1974, Mr. W. B. Goode filed Form C-103 with the Commission which indicated a change of operator from Tyra & Tyra to him as owner of 62.5% of the working interest in the well. If there is a dispute as to this fact, it is a matter which should be resolved between you and Mr. Goode.




