ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. October 15, 1952,
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico,
hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 20th day of October, 1952, the Commission, a
quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the ex-
hibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the Com-
mission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the West Dollarhide-Drinkard Pool, Lea County, New Mexico,
as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

Township 24 South, Range 38 East, NMPM
E/2 Section 31

(3) That the Teas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore
classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

Township 20 South, Range 33 East, NMPM
NE/4 Section 14

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission be, and the
same hereby is approved, as follows:

(1) That the boundaries of the West Dollarhide-Drinkard Pool, Lea
County, New Mexico, be, and the same hereby are extended to include:

Township 24 South, Range 38 East, NMPM
E/2 Section 31

(2) That the boundaries of the Teas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico,
be and the same hereby are extended to include:

Township 20 South, Range 33 East, NMPM
NE/4 Section 14

DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove designated.

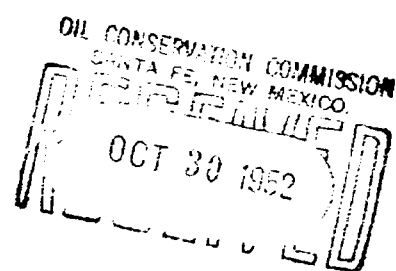

A Case No. 415 consists of Sections A and B. Section A dealing with the proposed extension to East Dollarhide-Brinkard Pool, Section B concerned with the proposed extension to Tens Pool. I have prepared plats of both sections, showing the pool as presently constituted and the proposed extension, and recommend that both extensions be made as advertised and as shown on these plats.

Q What is your reason for the extensions?

A To include wells producing from this source of supply in these designated pools.

Q The same common source of supply then?

A Yes.

Q Will you mark those as Exhibits 1 and 2 specifically, and they will be offered into evidence?
